**Title:** Student Body Association Fee—San Jose State University

**Effective Date:** December 20, 1993

**Supersedes:** Executive Order No. 487

Effective with the Spring Semester 1994, the Student Body Association Fee Schedule requested by San Jose State University is approved for implementation. This action is taken pursuant to Chapter III, Section 6, subdivision "c" of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees. Student Body Association fees shall be collected in the amounts specified in this Order, except as waived in individual cases, pursuant to Education Code Section 89300.
