Executive Order No: 653

Title: Student Body Center Fee—California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo

Effective Date: May 30, 1996

Supersedes: Executive Order No. 641

The Student Body Association Fee Schedule revision requested by California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo is approved for implementation. The fee schedule authorized herein shall supersede all such fees previously authorized for California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo. Student Body Association fees shall be collected in the amounts specified in this Order, except as waived in individual cases, pursuant to Education Code Section 89300. This action is taken pursuant to Chapter III, Section 6, subdivision "c" of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees.


This order clarifies that the fee schedule adopted first with Executive Order 641 has its progressive increases begin in the Fall Quarters. The dollar amounts remain unchanged.
