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Executive Order No.: 660

Title: Student Body Center Fee—California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo

Effective Date: August 22, 1996

Supersedes: Executive Order No. 535

Effective with the winter quarter 1997, the Student Body Center Fee Schedule requested by California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo is approved for implementation. The fee schedule authorized herein shall supersede all such fees previously authorized for California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo. This action is taken pursuant to Chapter III, Section 6, subdivision "d" of the Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees.

The Student Body Center Fee shall be charged as herein authorized, pursuant to Education Code Section 90012, subdivision (c) and Education Code Section 90068.
