



Subject: Campus User Fee for Anthropology 140 Executive Order No. 684

I am transmitting to you a copy of Executive Order No. 684 which authorizes California State University, Long Beach to establish a new campus user fee for Anthropology 140, Ireland Travel Study Course. Based upon a review of the consultation process employed by the campus and upon the recommendation of the Student Fee Advisory Committee, appropriate and meaningful consultation has occurred as required by the Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06.

In accordance with policy of The California State University, the campus president has the responsibility for implementing Executive Orders where applicable and for maintaining the campus repository and index for all Executive Orders.


Title: Campus User Fee for Anthropology 140
California State University, Long Beach

Effective Date: July 15, 1998

Supersedes: No Previous Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89708, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective with the Fall term 1998, California State University, Long Beach is authorized to establish a campus user fee for Anthropology 140, Ireland Travel Study Course, in an amount not to exceed \$2,000, an amount adequate, in the long run, to meet the cost of maintaining this program (Education Code Section 89708). Pursuant to section 89704 of the Education Code, money received from this fee is deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the State University Continuing Education Revenue Fund and is appropriated without regard to fiscal year for the support and development of self-supporting instructional programs.
