This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective with the fall term 1998, the California State University, Chico is authorized to establish the mandatory miscellaneous course fees in accordance with the schedule on Attachment A. Pursuant to section 89724(a) of the Education Code, monies received from these fees are appropriated for the support of the university in addition to such other amounts as may be appropriated therefor by the Legislature. Revenues received from these fees must be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund (Government Code Section 16300 et seq.).
