

Subject: Executive Order No. 686 Establishing New Mandatory
Miscellaneous Course Fees

I am transmitting to you a copy of Executive Order No. 686 which authorizes California State University, Sacramento to establish new campus mandatory miscellaneous course fees as listed on Attachment A. Based upon a review of the consultation process employed by the campus and upon the recommendation of the Student Fee Advisory Committee, appropriate and meaningful consultation has occurred as required by the Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06.

In accordance with policy of The California State University, the campus president has the responsibility for implementing Executive Orders where applicable and for maintaining the campus repository and index for all Executive Orders.



Executive Order No.: 686
Title: Mandatory Miscellaneous Course Fees, California State University, Sacramento
Effective Date: August 7, 1998
Supersedes: No Previous Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective with the fall term 1998, the California State University, Sacramento is authorized to establish the mandatory miscellaneous course fees in accordance with the schedule on Attachment A. Pursuant to section 89724(a) of the Education Code, monies received from these fees are appropriated for the support of the university in addition to such other amounts as may be appropriated therefor by the Legislature. Revenues received from these fees must be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund (Government Code Section 16300 *et seq.*).
