Subject: Executive Order No. 689 authorizing San Diego State University to establish a new campus user fee for services charged to the University One-Card

I am transmitting to you a copy of Executive Order No. 689 which authorizes the San Diego State University to establish a new campus user fee for services charged to the University One-Card. Based upon a review of the consultation process employed by the campus and upon the recommendation of the Student Fee Advisory Committee, appropriate and meaningful consultation has occurred as required by the Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06.

In accordance with policy of The California State University, the campus president has the responsibility for implementing Executive Orders where applicable and for maintaining the campus repository and index for all Executive Orders.


Title: Campus User Fee for Services Charged to the University One-Card
San Diego State University

Effective Date: October 8, 1998

Supersedes: No Previous Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective during the 1998 fall semester, the San Diego State University is authorized to establish a campus user fee for services charged to the University One-Card. The one-card deposits are held in a trust account (Education Code Section 89721(g)) until such time as the student uses the I.D. Card to pay for the following services: copier and printing fees (\$.10/page); laundry fees in residence halls (\$.75/wash and \$.50/dry); and long distance calling card fees (\$.15/minute). Pursuant to section 89724(a) of the Education Code, money received from this fee is appropriated for the support of the university in addition to such other amounts as may be appropriated by the Legislature.
