

**Title:** Mandatory Fee - Freshman Orientation Training Program

User Fee – Freshman Orientation Lodging and Food Service

Penalty Fees – ID Card Replacement; Residence Room Lockout Charge

**Effective Date:** Fall Semester 1999

**Supersedes:** No Previous Executive Order

This Executive order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective in the fall 1999 semester, California Maritime Academy is authorized to establish the following new fees:


A new mandatory fee for the Freshman Orientation Training Program. The fee amount for this program is \$24.

A new user fee for the Freshman Orientation Lodging and Food Service. The fee amount for lodging is \$40 and the fee amount for food service is \$36 for a total of \$76.

New penalty fees for: ID Card Replacement; Residence Room Lockout Charge. The ID Card Replacement fee is \$10. The Residence Room Lockout Charge fee is \$10.

The new mandatory and campus penalty fees must be deposited in the General Fund in the State Treasury and are appropriated for the support of the University pursuant to Education Code Section 89724(a). The new campus user fee may be deposited in a local trust account pursuant to Education Code Section 89721(g) and must be used solely to meet the costs of providing the services.
