

Subject: Executive Order No. 708 authorizing California State University,
Los Angeles to establish new campus user and penalty fees for Microsoft
Software

I am transmitting to you a copy of Executive Order No. 708, which authorizes California State University, Los Angeles to establish the following new fees:

User fee: Microsoft Software Rental Fee

Penalty fees: Microsoft Software Deposit Fee; and
Microsoft Software Damage Fee

In accordance with policy of the California State University, the campus president has the responsibility for implementing Executive Orders where applicable and for maintaining the campus repository and index for all Executive Orders.


This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective summer quarter 1999, California State University, Los Angeles, is authorized to establish the following new fees:

A new campus user fee for Microsoft Software Rental. The fee amount will range from \$20 to \$40.

New penalty fees for Microsoft Software Deposit, and Microsoft Software Damage Fee. The fee amount for Microsoft Software Deposit will range from \$25 to \$50. The fee amount for Microsoft Software Damage will range from \$8 to \$26.

The new campus user fee may be deposited in a local trust account pursuant to Education Code Section 89721(g) and must be used solely to meet the costs of providing the service. The new campus penalty fees must be deposited in the General Fund in the State Treasury and are appropriated for the support of the University pursuant to Education Code Section 89724(a).
