

**Title:** Miscellaneous Course Fees for Art 40H and Art 145,  
California State University, Sacramento

**Effective Date:** Spring 2000 Semester

**Supersedes:** No Previous Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective spring 2000, California State University, Sacramento, is authorized to establish optional miscellaneous course fees for Art 40H (Beginning Printmaking/Portfolio) and Art 145 (Advanced Printmaking). The fee amount for Art 40H (Beginning Printmaking/Portfolio) is \$25, and the fee amount for Art 145 (Advanced Printmaking) is \$25. The new optional miscellaneous course fees may be deposited in a local trust account pursuant to Education Code Section 89721(g) and must be used solely to meet the costs of providing the service.
