

User fee: Fingerprinting Services


**Effective Date:** Fall Quarter 1999

**Supersedes:** No Previous Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective fall quarter 1999, California State University, Los Angeles, is authorized to establish a new campus user fee for Fingerprinting Services. The fee amount for this service is \$12 and will cover the cost to maintain and support the fingerprint operations.

The new campus user fee may be deposited in a local trust account pursuant to Education Code Section 89721(g) and must be used solely to meet the costs of providing the service.
