

**Executive Order No.:** 719

**Title:** Campus Penalty Fee: Enrollment Confirmation Deposit,  
San Diego State University

**Effective Date:** Spring Semester 2000

**Supersedes:** No Previous Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective spring semester 2000, San Diego State University is authorized to establish a new campus penalty fee for Enrollment Confirmation Deposit. The Enrollment Confirmation Deposit fee amount is \$100 and will be held to confirm intention to enroll in a subsequent semester. Upon the student's registration, the deposit will be transferred to offset a portion of the student's State University Fee. If the student fails to enroll, the deposit will be forfeited and used to cover costs associated with the failure to enroll. Pursuant to section 89721(f) of the Education Code, miscellaneous receipts in the nature of deposits subject to return upon approval of a proper application may be deposited in a local trust account.
