

Executive Order No.: 726

Title: Campus Mandatory Distance Learning Fee for the Fire Protection Program, California State University, Los Angeles

Effective Date: January 26, 2000

Supersedes: No Previous Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective January 26, 2000, California State University, Los Angeles is authorized to establish a campus mandatory Distance Learning Fee for the Fire Protection Program. The fee amount for this service is \$50 and will cover broadcast costs, including costs associated with administering distance learning services.

Revenue from the new campus mandatory fee shall be deposited in the General Fund pursuant to Education Code Section 89724(a) to augment the support funds appropriated to the university in the year of receipt.
