The Executive Order authorizing California State University, Chico to establish Education Curriculum and Instruction 313, miscellaneous course fee; Foreign Language Lab, miscellaneous course fee; and ID Card Replacement (Students), penalty fee, was inadvertently assigned the same number as another Executive Order. Consequently, we have assigned a new number to CSU, Chico's fee executive order. We are transmitting herewith Executive Order 728, which replaces Executive Order 720.

The other Executive Order 720, concerning the approval procedure for off-campus centers remains unchanged.

Executive Order No.: 728

Title: Educational Curriculum Instruction 313, miscellaneous course fee; Foreign Language Lab, miscellaneous course fee; and ID Card Replacement (Students), penalty fee; California State University, Chico

Effective Date: Spring Semester 2000

Supersedes: Renumbered from Executive Order No. 720

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective spring semester 2000, California State University, Chico is authorized to establish the following: Educational Curriculum Instruction (EDCI) 313, optional miscellaneous course fee for art supplies with a fee amount of \$10 per semester; Foreign Language Lab, optional miscellaneous course fee for lab services that include printing and supplies with a fee amount of \$5 per semester; and ID Card Replacement (Students), penalty fee for first, second or more ID card replacements within an academic year with fee amounts ranging between \$2 and \$10.

Revenue from the above optional miscellaneous course fees may be deposited in a local trust account pursuant to Education Code Section 89721(g) and must be used solely to meet the costs of providing the service. The new campus penalty fee must be deposited in the General Fund in the State Treasury and is appropriated for the support of the University pursuant to Education Code Section 89724(a).
