

**Executive Order No.: 733**

**Title:** Campus User Fees: Livescan Processing Fee, and Livescan Fingerprint fee  
Humboldt State University

**Effective Date:** March 3, 2000

**Supersedes:** No Previous Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89704, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 05-96-06 and consonant with Executive Order No. 661.

Effective March 3, 2000, Humboldt State University is authorized to establish user fees: Livescan Processing Fee, and Livescan Fingerprint Fee. The Livescan Processing Fee amount will range between \$15 and \$124 and will cover costs of providing electronic processing for criminal records. The Livescan Fingerprint Fee amount will range between \$10 and \$12 and will cover services rendered in rolling and transmitting fingerprints and for machine maintenance and supplies.

Pursuant to section 89721(g) of the Education Code, monies collected from this fee may be deposited in local trust accounts and must be used solely to meet the costs of providing the services.
