Subject: Executive Order No. 735 authorizing California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo to establish a Printing Fee

I am transmitting to you a copy of Executive Order No. 735, which authorizes California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo to establish a Printing Fee.

In accordance with the fee policy of the California State University, each campus is required to report to the chancellor for the most recently completed fiscal year a complete inventory of all fees charged to students and the total revenue collected for each fee. Further, the campus president has the responsibility for implementing executive orders where applicable and for maintaining the campus repository and index for all executive orders.

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00.

Effective March 23, 2000, California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo, is authorized to establish a Printing Fee. Fee amounts for printing services are \$.10 per black and white page and \$.25 per color page.

Pursuant to section 89721(g) of the Education Code, monies collected from this fee may be deposited in local trust accounts and must be used solely to meet the costs of providing the services.
