

Executive Order: 755
Title: Enrollment Confirmation Deposit Fee; California State University, Fullerton
Effective Date: September 12, 2000
Supersedes: No Prior Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00, and consonant with Executive Order Number 740.

Effective immediately, California State University, Fullerton is authorized to establish a Category IV, Enrollment Confirmation Deposit Fee at a fee rate of \$50. The Enrollment Confirmation Deposit Fee is charged to first-time freshmen. The fee is credited against registration fees in the event that the student enrolls. The fee is not refunded to those who choose not to enroll at California State University, Fullerton.

Pursuant to section 89724(a) of the Education Code, revenues from this fee shall be deposited in the State Treasury and credited to the General Fund for the support of the university in addition to such other amounts as may be appropriated therefor by the Legislature.
