**Title:** Counseling Diversion Programs Fee; San Diego State University


**Effective Date:** June 13, 2001

**Supersedes:** No Prior Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00, and consonant with Executive Order Number 740.

Effective June 13, 2001, San Diego State University is authorized to establish a Category III, Counseling Diversion Programs Fee at a rate of \$75. The Counseling Diversion Programs Fee will assist in early intervention and prevention education alternatives for students who are cited by campus officials for incidents involving violations with respect to the use of alcohol and other drugs and/or violent behavior that puts others at risk. Each diversion program includes an individual assessment with each student, a full-day education and treatment group, and an individual follow-up session six weeks after completion of full-day education.

Pursuant to Section 89724(a) of the Education Code, revenue collected from the Counseling Diversion Programs fee shall be deposited in the State Treasury and credited to the General Fund for the support of the university in addition to such other amounts as may be appropriated therefor by the Legislature.
