Attached is a copy of Executive Order No. 790, which authorizes California State University, Sacramento to establish a Category III, Family and Consumer Sciences Dietetic Internship Application Processing Fee, and establish Category III Continuing Education per unit fees for Masters in Health Care Administration, Masters of Social Work, Masters of Business Administration for Working Professionals, Post Graduate Certificate for Family Nurse Practitioners and Bachelors of Arts in Child Development.

Title: Family and Consumer Sciences Dietetic Internship Application Processing Fee and Continuing Education per unit fees for Masters in Health Care Administration, Masters of Social Work, Masters of Business Administration for Working Professionals, Post Graduate Certificate for Family Nurse Practitioners and Bachelors of Arts in Child Development; California State University, Sacramento

Effective Date: August 29, 2001

Supersedes: No Prior Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued pursuant to authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00, and consonant with Executive Order Number 740.

Effective August 29, 2001, California State University, Sacramento is authorized to establish a Category III, Family and Consumer Sciences Dietetic Internship Application Processing Fee, and establish Category III Continuing Education per unit fees for Masters in Health Care Administration, Masters of Social Work, Masters of Business Administration for Working Professionals, Post Graduate Certificate for Family Nurse Practitioners and Bachelors of Arts in Child Development.

The Family and Consumer Sciences Dietetic Internship Application Processing Fee is established at a fee rate of \$30.

The Continuing Education per unit fees are established at the following fee rates:

Masters in Health Care Administration, \$350
Masters of Social Work, \$350
Masters of Business Administration for Working Professionals, \$500
Post Graduate Certificate for Family Nurse Practitioners, \$275
Bachelors of Arts in Child Development, \$250


Pursuant to Section 89724(a) of the Education Code, revenue collected from the Family and Consumer Sciences Dietetic Internship Application Processing Fee shall be deposited in the State Treasury and credited to the General Fund for the support of the university in addition to such other amounts as may be appropriated therefor by the Legislature.

Page Two

Revenue collected from continuing education fees may be deposited in the State University Continuing Education Revenue Fund in the State Treasury. Alternatively, pursuant to Education Code Section 89721(i), the revenue from continuing education fees may be deposited in a local trust account. In either case, the fee revenues are appropriated for the support and development of self-instructional programs of the California State University.
