

**Executive Order:** 797  
**Title:** Critical Response Unit  
**Effective Date:** November 29, 2001  
**Supersedes:** No Previous Executive Order.

It is the policy of the California State University (CSU) that resources and facilities of the CSU and its various public safety departments will be made available to mitigate the effects of natural disasters, to prevent and mitigate the effects of civil disorders and to protect life and property when local campus officials deem a necessity exists to insure and protect public welfare.

Accordingly, in 1993 the CSU established a Critical Response Unit (CRU) composed of selected officers from various CSU campus public safety departments. The CRU reflects and supports CSU's policy of Critical response. The CRU may consist of geographical subunits as determined appropriate. The CRU's participating personnel are to receive training to prepare them to handle public safety issues related to natural disaster, civil disorder and protection of life and property.

The Chancellor or Vice Chancellor of Human Resources shall activate the Critical Response Unit at the request of a campus president or designated official as required.
