**Executive Order:** 808

**Title:** Stored/Impounded Vehicle Fee; San Jose State University


**Effective Date:** February 15, 2002

**Supersedes:** No Prior Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued under the authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Sections 1, 2 and 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00, and consonant with Executive Order Number 740.

Effective February 15, 2002, San Jose State University is authorized to establish a Category IV Stored/Impounded Vehicle Fee. The Stored/Impounded Vehicle Fee rate is established at \$60. The fee will include the cost of towing, vehicle citations, as well as the cost to review, record and process reports.

Revenue from this fee may be deposited in the State Treasury and credited to the General Fund for the support of the university in addition to such other amounts as may be appropriated by the Legislature as required by Education Code Section 89724(a).
