Title: Evaluation of Transcripts Fee for Verification Statement Issuance to Non-CSULA Students; California State University, Los Angeles


Effective Date: May 16, 2002

Supersedes: No Prior Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued under the authority granted by Education Code Sections 89035, 89700, and Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Sections 1, 2 and 6-f-1.

Effective May 16, 2002, California State University, Los Angeles is authorized to establish an Evaluation of Transcripts Fee for Verification Statement Issuance to Non-CSULA Students. This fee will cover the cost of materials and supplies associated with evaluation of non-CSULA student undergraduate and graduate transcripts to determine courses needed for a Verification Statement as required by the American Dietetic Association for accredited dietetic internships. The Evaluation of Transcripts Fee for Verification Statement Issuance to Non-CSULA Students is established at a fee rate of \$50.

In accordance with Education Code Section 89721(g), revenue collected from this fee may be deposited in a local trust account, and shall be used solely to meet the costs of providing these services.
