Executive Order: 826

Title: Printing and Scanning Fee; Humboldt State University


Effective Date: July 8, 2002

Supersedes: No Prior Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued under the authority granted by Education Code Section 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Section 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00 and consonant with Executive Order Number 740.

Effective July 8, 2002, Humboldt State University is authorized to establish Category III Printing and Scanning fees. The Printing Fee is established at a fee range from \$.10 to \$.20 per copy, and the Scanning Fee is established at \$.10 per copy.

In accordance with Education Code Section 89721(g), revenue collected from this fee may be deposited in a local trust account, and shall be used solely to meet the costs of providing these services.
