Title: Nursing State Licensing Assessment Fee; California State University,
Long Beach


Effective Date: August 9, 2002

Supersedes: No Prior Executive Order

This Executive Order is issued under the authority granted by Education Code Sections 89035, 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Sections 1, 2 and 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00, and consonant with Executive Order No. 740.

Effective August 9, 2002, California State University, Long Beach is authorized to establish a Category III Nursing State Licensing Assessment Fee. The Nursing State Licensing Assessment Fee will cover the cost to provide assessment testing at the completion of the first four semesters of the program so students and faculty can plan for remediation prior to state licensing exams. The fee is established at a fee range of \$56 to \$67.

Revenue collected from the Nursing State Licensing Assessment Fee shall be deposited in the State Treasury and credited to the General Fund as required by Section 89724(a).
