Title: Psychology Department Test Library Late Fee; Humboldt State University


Effective Date: March 13, 2003

Supersedes: No Prior Executive Order

This executive order is issued under the authority granted by Education Code Sections 89035, 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Sections 1, 2 and 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00, and consonant with Executive Order No. 740.

Effective March 13, 2003, Humboldt State University is authorized to establish a Category IV, Psychology Department Test Library Fee. The fee will assist in covering costs incurred when students are late in returning Psychology Department restricted use examination kits, assessment manuals, and assessment tools. The Psychology Department Test Library Late Fee is established at a fee rate of \$5 per day.

In accordance with Section 89724(a) of the Education Code, revenue collected from the Psychology Department Test Library Late Fee shall be deposited in the State Treasury and credited to the General Fund for the support of the university in addition to such other amounts as may be appropriated therefor by the Legislature.
