Title: Therapeutic Massage, Augmented Health Services Fee; California State University, Sacramento


Effective Date: April 16, 2003

Supersedes: No Prior Executive Order

This executive order is issued under the authority granted by Education Code Sections 89035, 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter III, Sections 1, 2 and 6-f-1, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00, and consonant with Executive Order Nos. 740 and 814.

Effective April 16, 2003, California State University, Sacramento is authorized to establish a Category III, Therapeutic Massage, Augmented Health Services Fee. The fee will cover the actual cost of 15-minute massage therapy available to students as part of augmented health services at the Student Health Center. The Therapeutic Massage, Augmented Health Services Fee is established at a fee rate of \$12.

Revenue collected from the Therapeutic Massage, Augmented Health Services Fee shall be deposited in a local trust account in accordance with Education Code Section 89721(i).
