


Memorandum of Understanding 4/15/15 (Addendum)

Pursuant to the Settlement of PERB Case No. LA-CE-1205-H, the parties entered into a Memorandum of Understanding that amended Articles 5.2 and 5.10 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

The parties further Agree that the following provisions will apply to the Association President while on full-time Association leave from their campus position.

- Visits to SUPA worksites for union activities, including the Association President's home campus, will be consistent with sections 5.5 & 5.6 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement.
- All State keys, fobs and access cards will be temporarily turned over to the department while the Association President is in the position.
- Upon approval of the Association President's home campus Chief of Police, the Association President may retain his/her locker and/or mailbox. If such access is approved, the President shall enter through the security check-in area of the Police Department, but will not require an escort. Under this provision, the Association President shall be allowed access to all common areas, but shall not enter private offices without specific authorization.


