Subject: 2012-13 Tuition Fee Increase

At its meeting held on November 16, 2011, the CSU Board of Trustees (BOT) approved a 2012-13 tuition increase of 9%. This means that the tuition fee will increase for all CSU students effective fall term 2012.

Please refer to the attachment "2012-13 Tuition Fee Increase-IP Payment Plan" for the specific amounts of the tuition rates for undergraduate/credential/graduate students. Please review the form, choose a payment option and return the form to us with your signature by December 20, 2011. A credit card payment form is attached if needed.

We recognize that this added cost will be a financial challenge for you. The Office of International Programs (OIP) will work with you in coming up with a payment plan for the additional cost.

As is always the case with OIP, any unexpended funds in your IP account will be refunded to you at the end of your academic year.
