Re: 2007 Annual Report of Crime Statistics

The California State University 2007 Annual Report of Crime Statistics represents a compilation of crime data reported to the Chancellor's Office by twenty-two campus police departments and the Maritime Academy Public Safety Department. The statistical overview is generally intended to offer a broad perspective of criminal activity occurring both on individual campuses and throughout the system. A copy of the full report is also attached.

The Part I Offenses reported systemwide during 2007 reflect an overall 10.3% decrease. The Part II Offenses reflect an overall 10.2% increase. Total crime reported systemwide reflects a 2.3% increase. State and Federal Legislature has significantly expanded statistical reporting requirements over the last ten years. Campuses report crime statistics on a monthly basis to the California Department of Justice, annually as part of the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act and to the U.S. Department of Education annually as part of the online statistics available on the Office of Post Secondary Education website.

It was our intent in this report to analyze total crime and the statistics may be different from the Department of Justice, Clery and CPEC statistics as their reporting requirements only request certain types of crimes. It is also important to note that statistics for past years may change as crimes are cleared and reclassified.

The information contained in this report provides the basis for compliance with legislatively mandated campus safety reports, which must be published and made available to all student and staff.

THE CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY 2007 ANNUAL REPORT OF CRIME STATISTICS

Overview

As recognized California law enforcement agencies, each CSU Department of Public Safety is required to provide the state Department of Justice with a monthly report outlining reported Part I offenses, suspected incidents of arson, and recorded arrests and citations. This information is forwarded to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for inclusion in their annual publication, "Crime in the United States."

The following report of systemwide statistics exceeds all mandated reporting requirements and is designed to assist CSU campuses in the preparation of campus crime reports. It likewise provides each campus with an updated profile of crime activity to assist in the planning and directing of future law enforcement/prevention activities.

The 2007 Annual Report of Crime Statistics is presented in two parts. The Annual Report includes systemwide statistics, a comparison between campuses and a summary of the statistics submitted annually from the campuses to the Chancellor's Office is included as an attachment.

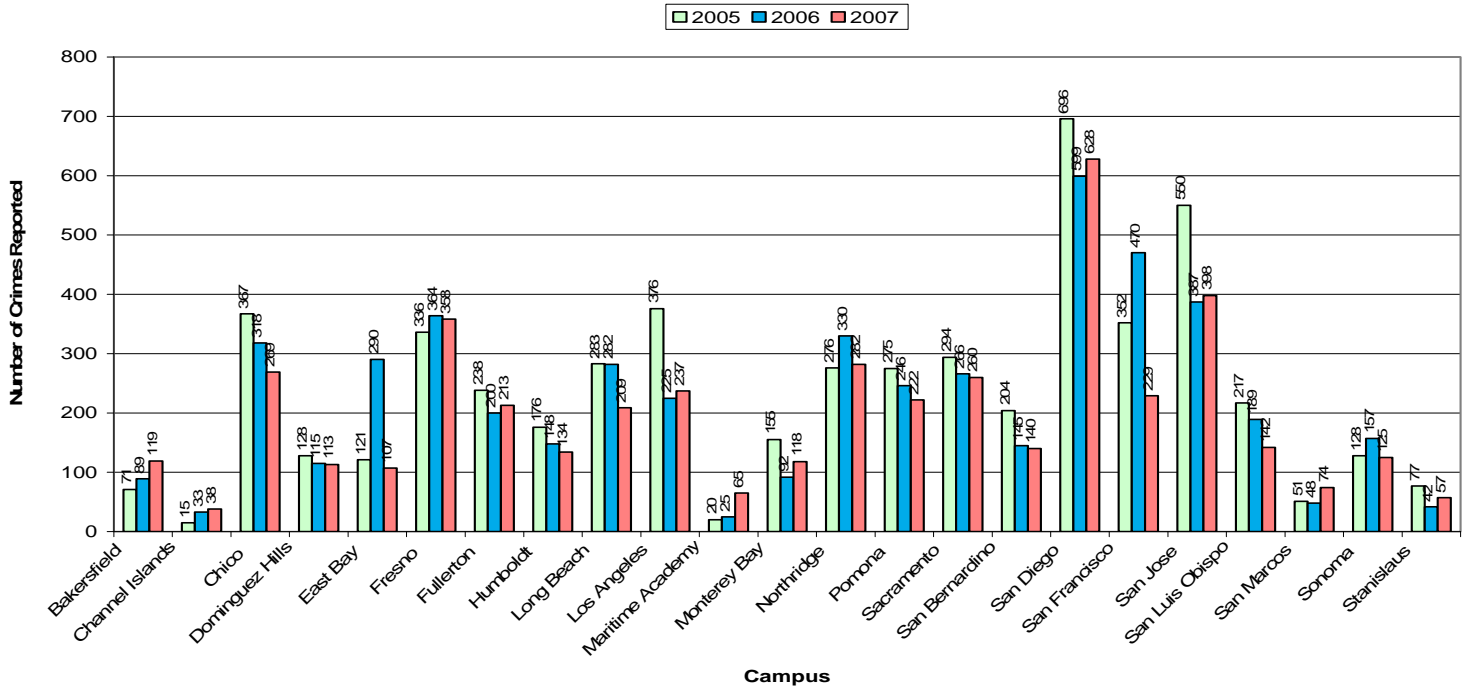

Part I Offenses

Part I Offenses:

Homicides, Rape, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, Arson, Burglary, Larceny/Theft, Motor Vehicle Theft

Total Part I offenses decreased by 523 incidents (-10.3%) in 2007 over the same reporting period in 2006.

- Total Violent Crimes increased by 21 incidents (14.7%)

Almost every category in violent crimes showed an increase in 2007:

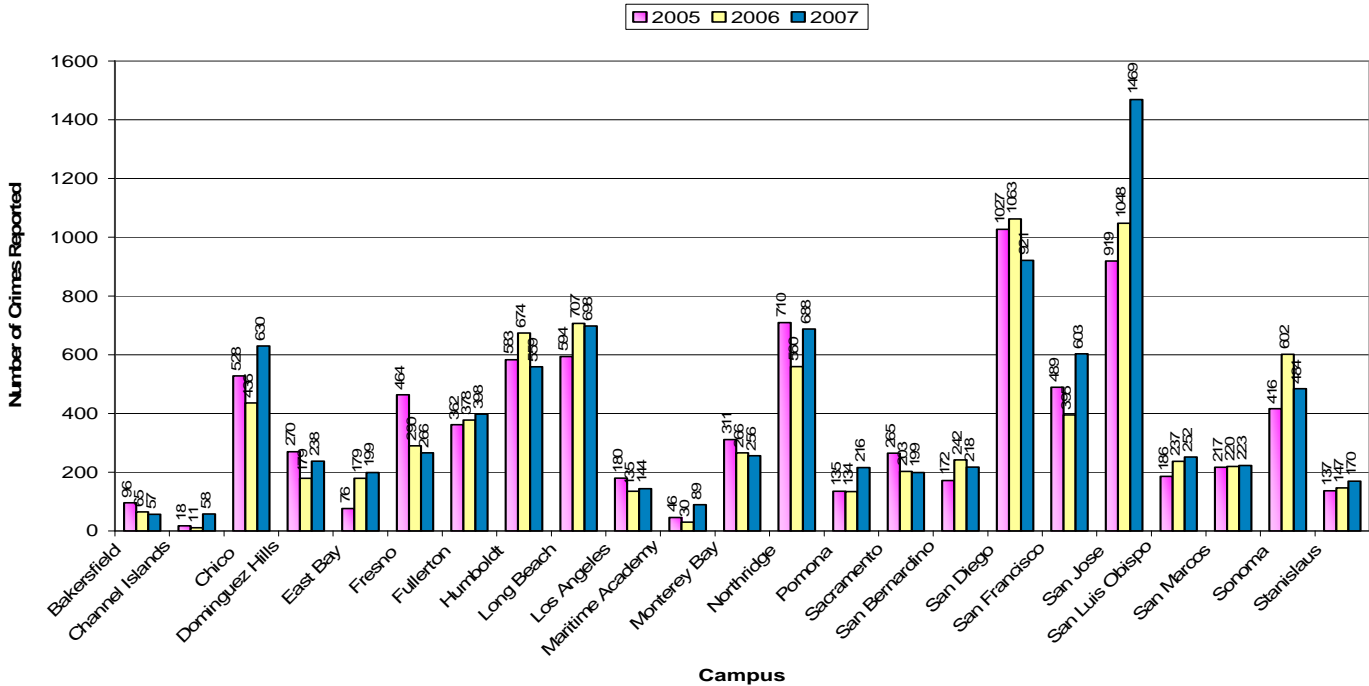
Homicides increased by one incident (100.0%) *corrected on 8/20/08
 Rapes increased by 13 incidents (39.4%)
 Robbery decreased by five incidents (-9.1%)
 Aggravated assaults increased by 12 incidents (21.8%)

- Total Property Crimes decreased by 544 incidents (-11.1%) in 2007

Arson decreased by eight incidents (-28.6%)
 Burglaries increased by 76 incidents (13.3%)
 Larceny/Thefts decreased by 482 incidents (-12.7%)
 Motor Vehicle Thefts decreased by 130 incidents (-25.4%)

Part II Offenses

2005 - 2007 Total Part II Offenses



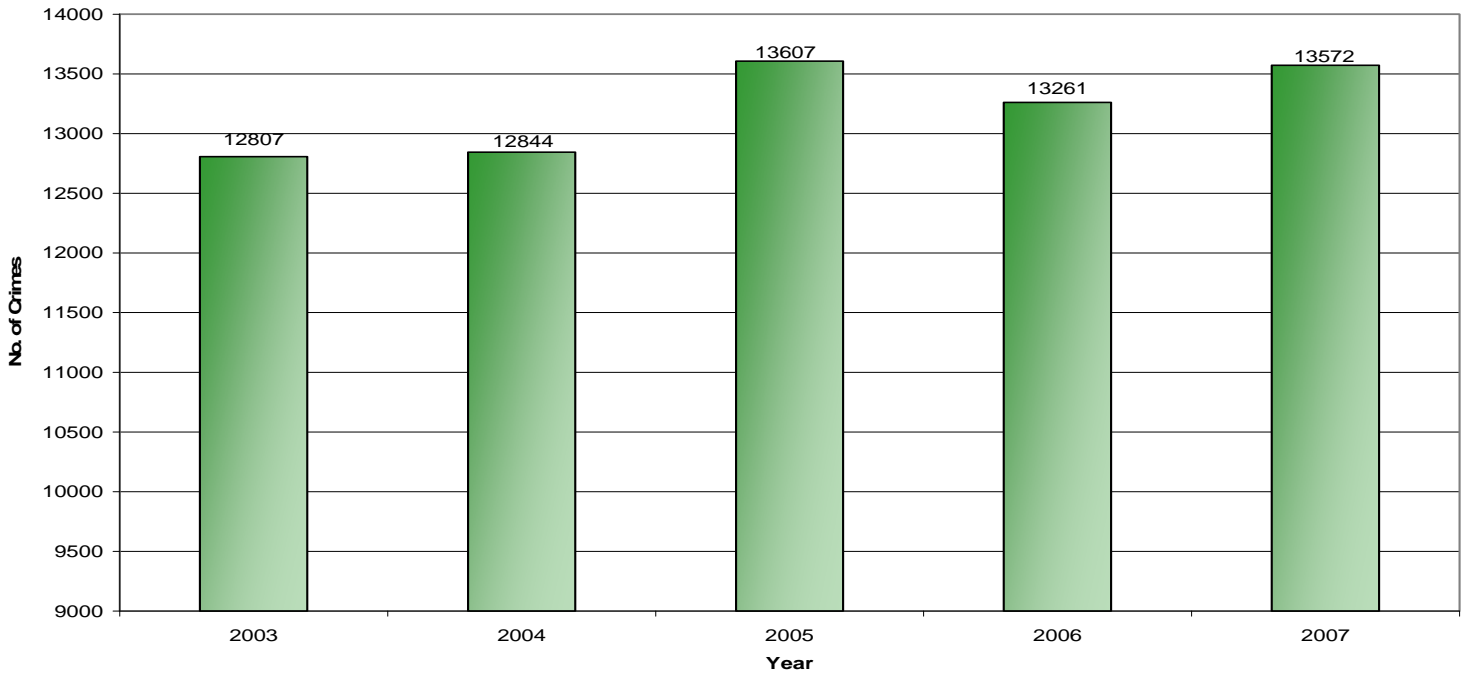
Part II Offenses encompass: simple assaults, vandalism, weapons possession, sex offenses other than rape, drug abuse violations, driving under the influence, violations of liquor laws, drunkenness, disorderly conduct, forgery/counterfeit, fraud, embezzlement, and stolen property.

Total Part II Offenses increased by 834 incidents (10.2%) in 2007 over the same reporting period in 2006.

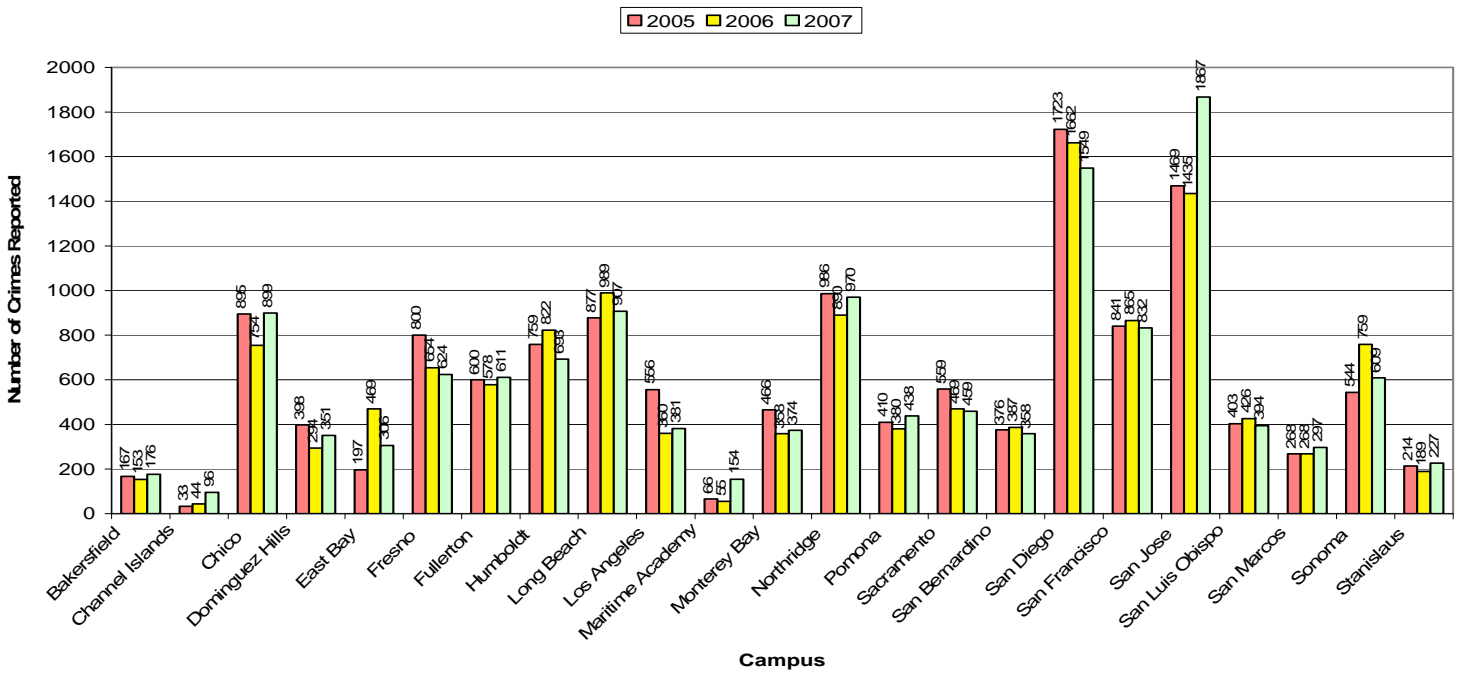
- Decreases were shown in seven categories: simple assault, weapons, other sex offenses, liquor laws, drunkenness, fraud, and stolen property.

2003 - 2007 Total Systemwide Crime



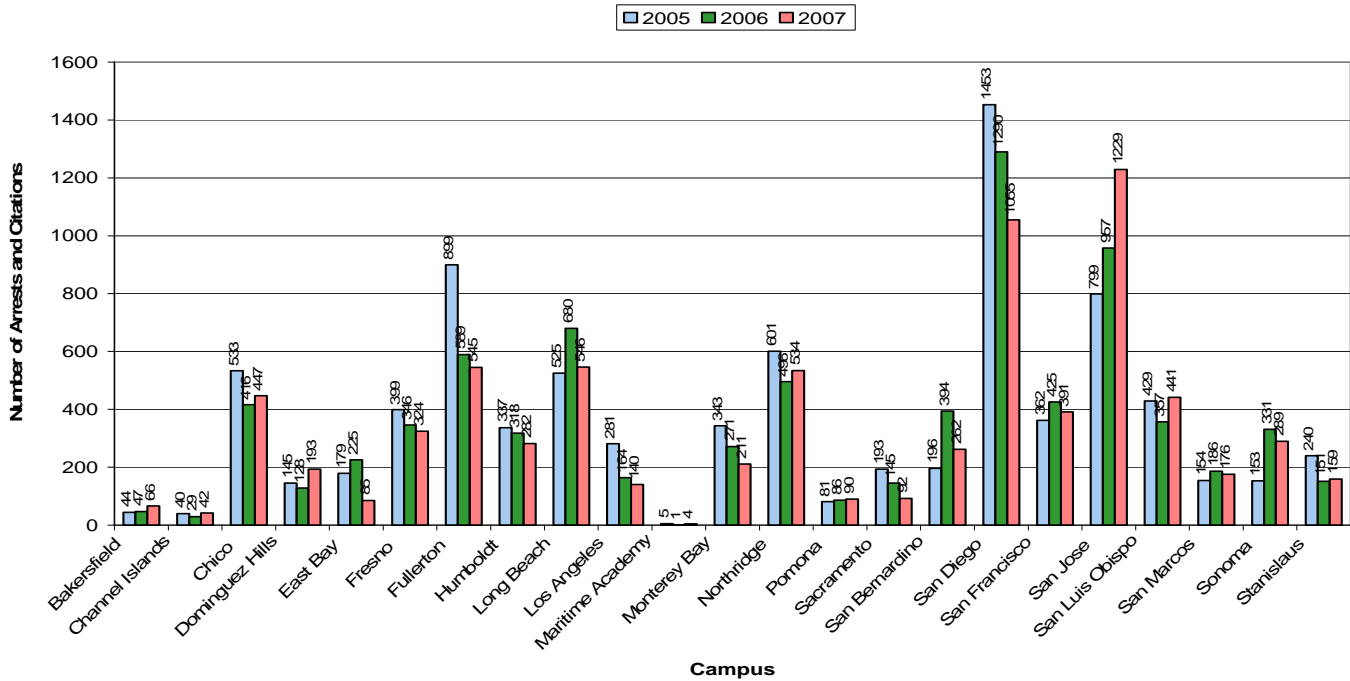
2005 - 2007 Comparison Between Campuses Total Crimes Reported



Total crime reported has increased by 311, with 13,261 crimes reported in 2006 compared to 13,572 reported in 2007 (2.3%).

Arrests/Citations

2005 - 2007 CSU Systemwide Arrests and Citations



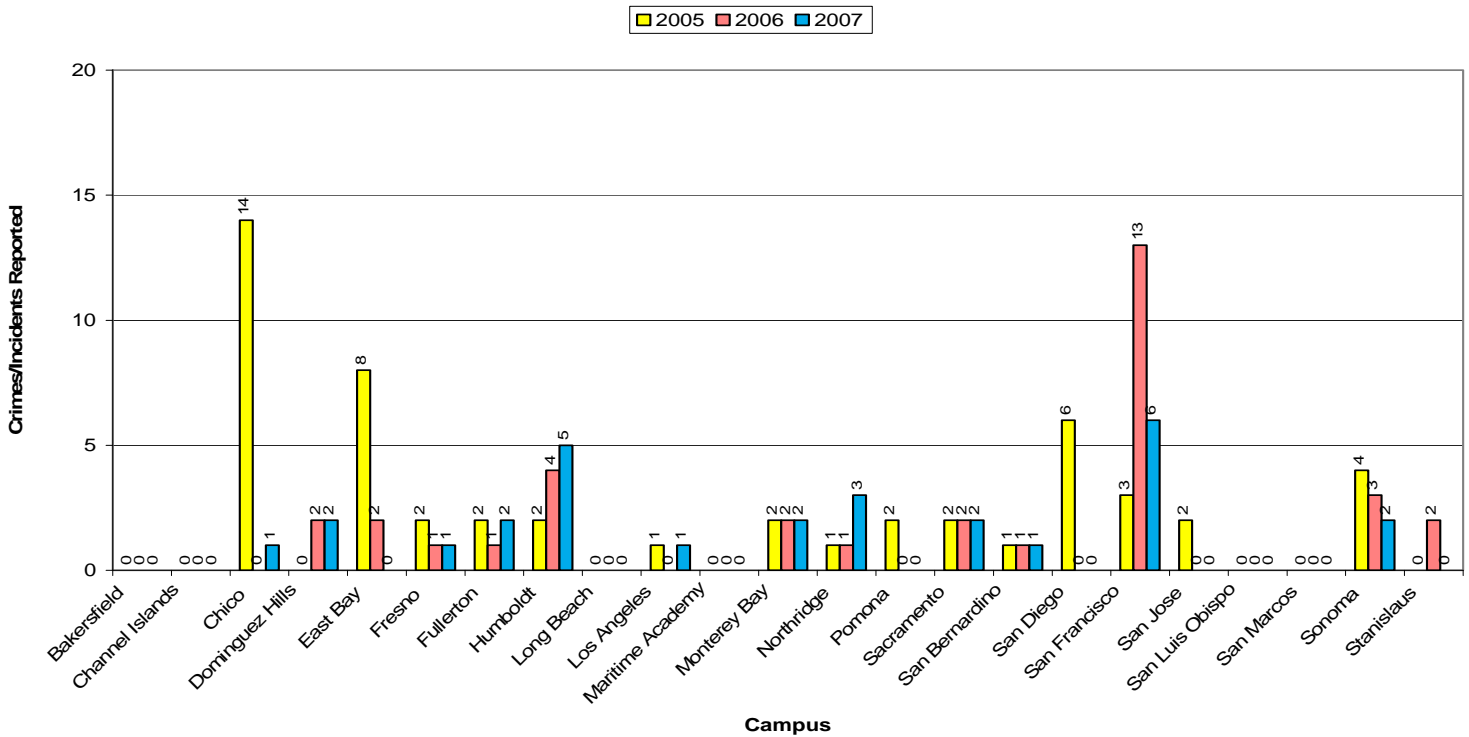
Total Arrests/Citations decreased by 429 (-5.3%) in 2007.

Arrests and Citations - Total number of arrests and/or citations recorded in the following categories:

- Penal Code Violations - The number of arrests for both felony and misdemeanor penal code violations showed a -0.7% decrease in misdemeanor arrests and a 5.5% increase in felony arrests for 2007.
- Vehicle Code Violations
- Health and Safety Violations (drug possession, drug selling, possession of dangerous and/or toxic materials, etc.)
- Business and Professions Violations (minor in possession of alcohol, purchase of alcohol by a minor, alcohol on school grounds)
- Local Code Violations (Municipal, Education, or Administrative Codes)
- Outside/Bench Warrants (failure to appear, failure to pay fines, warrants for arrest for previous violations)

Other Crimes

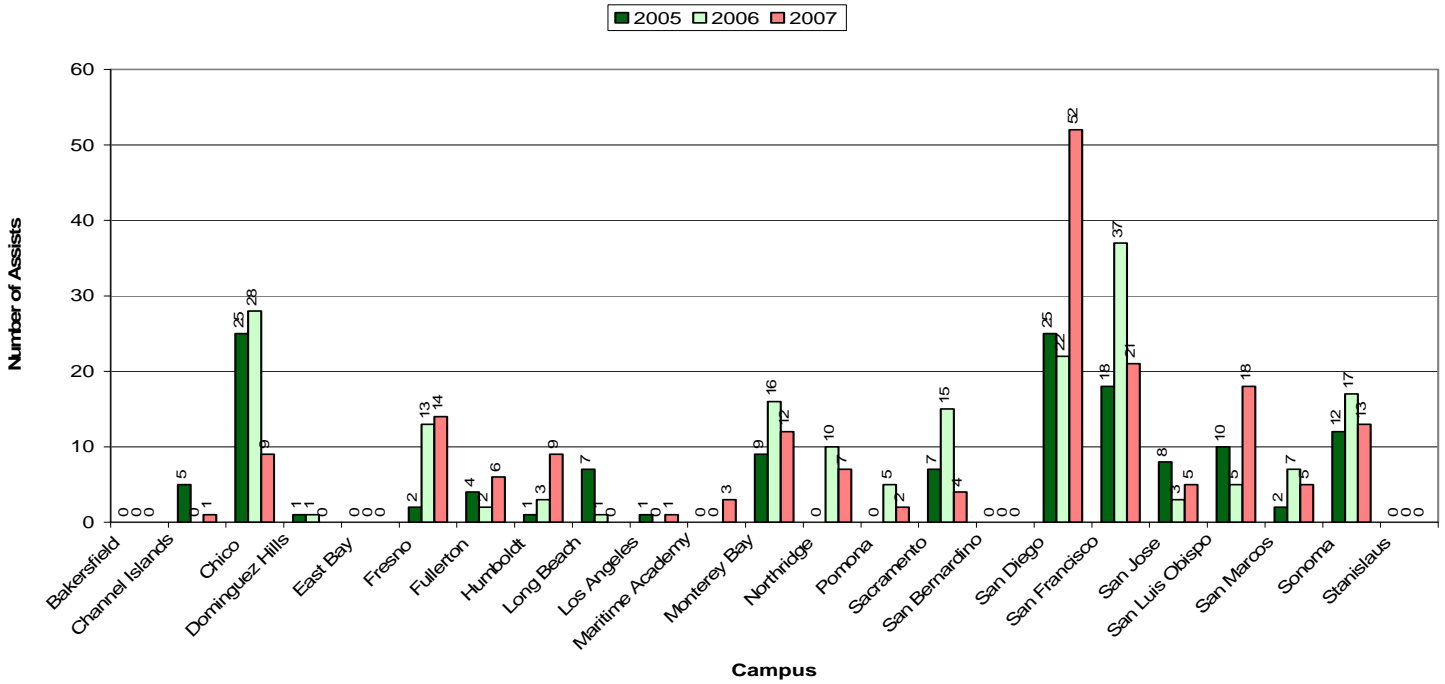
2005 - 2007 CSU Systemwide Hate Crime/Incidents Statistics



Other crimes also reported include hate crimes, hate incidents and domestic violence calls. In 2007, hate crimes decreased by 8 incidents (-40.0%) and hate incidents increased by two incidents (14.3%). Domestic violence calls decreased by 25 (-21.4%).

Medical Assists

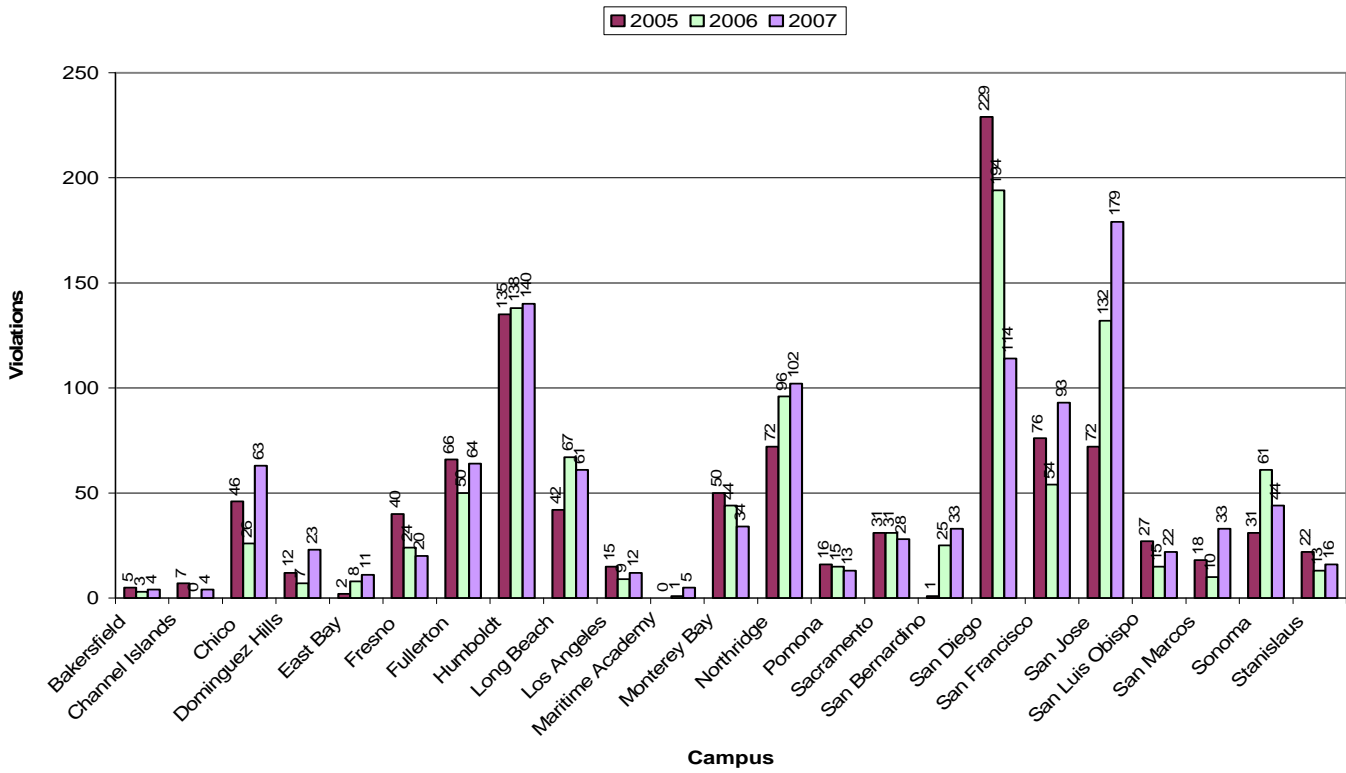
2005 - 2007 CSU Systemwide Medical Assists

Drug Abuse Violations

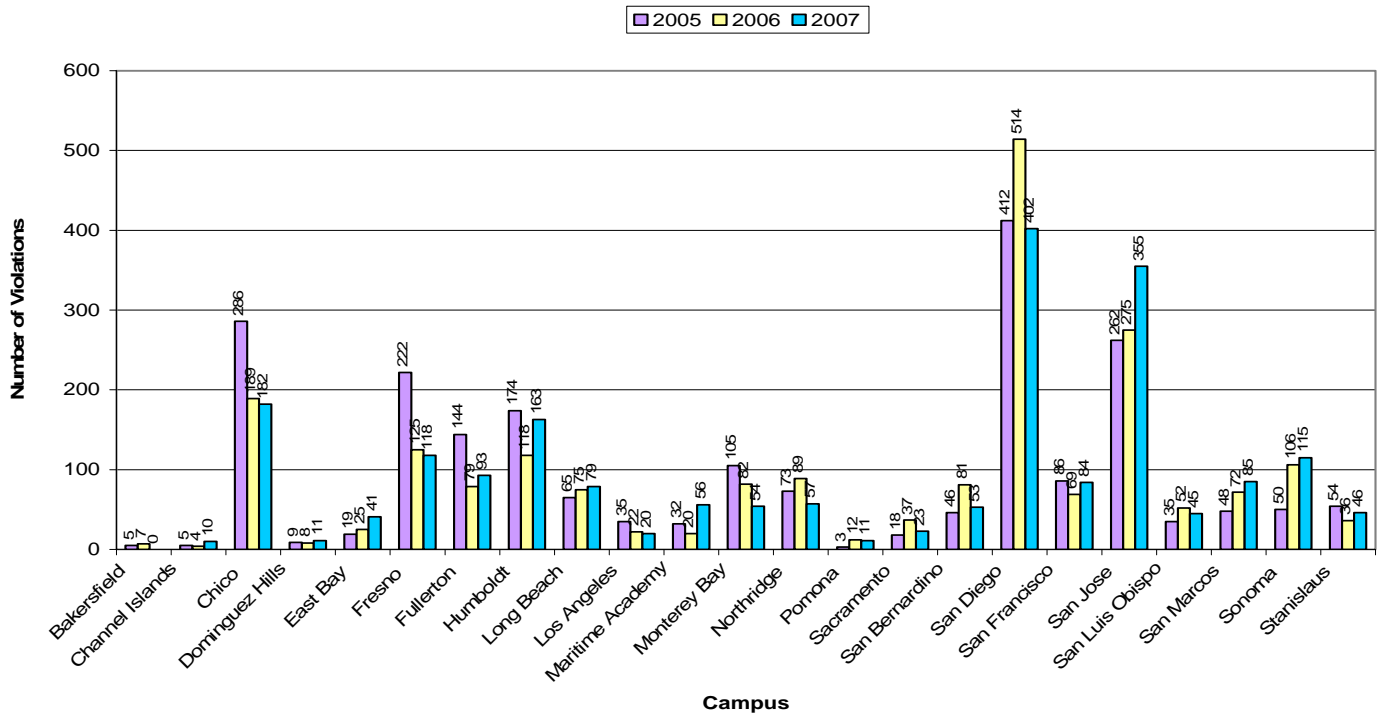
2005 - 2007 CSU Systemwide Drug Abuse Violations

Alcohol-related Violations

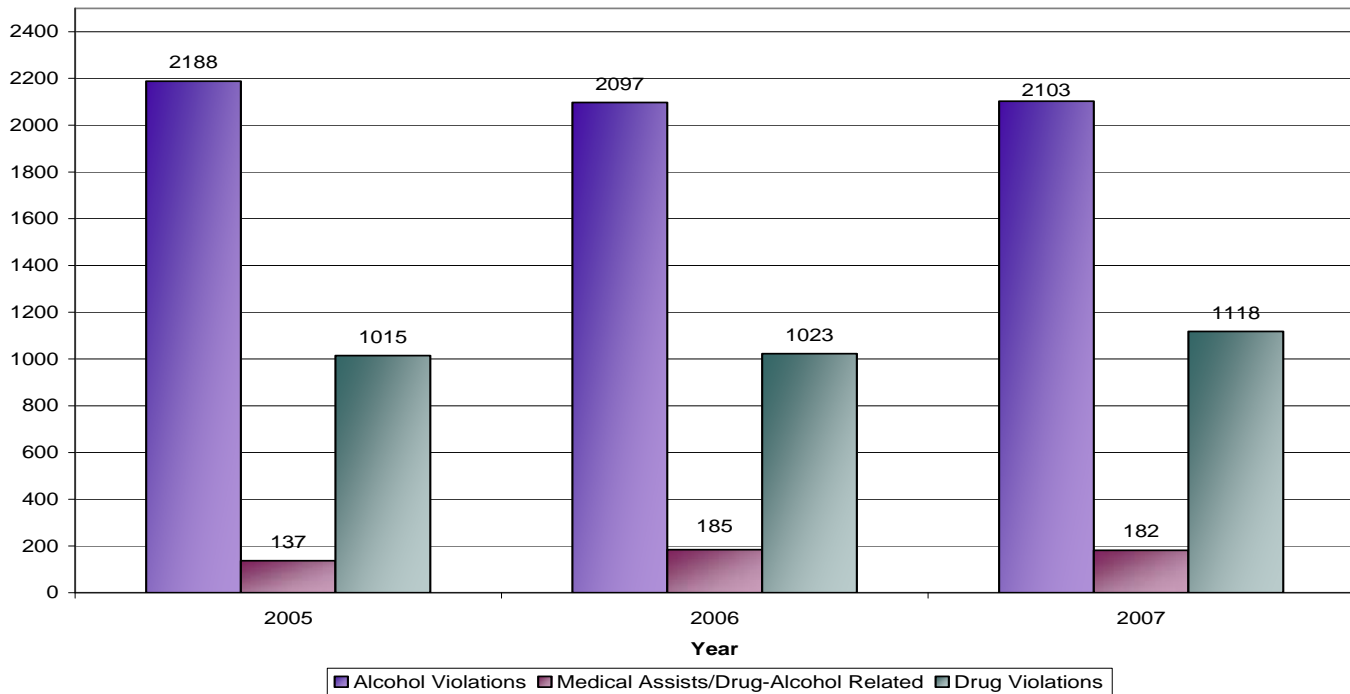
2005 - 2007 CSU Systemwide Comparison

Violations of liquor laws decreased by 30 violations (-5.2%) from 2006 to 2007, while driving under the influence increased by 8.0% or 65 violations in the same time period. Drunkenness violations dropped to 678 in 2007, down 29 violations from 2006, a -4.1% decrease.

Systemwide Comparison of Alcohol Violations, Medical Assists and Drug Violations

(Consisting of Alcohol Violations, Medical Assists, Drug Violations)



Alcohol violations showed an increase in 2007, up to 2,103. Drug violations decreased slightly in 2007 with 95 less violations than 2006. Medical assists relating to drugs and alcohol decreased to 182 in 2007, down from 185 the previous year.
