Channel Islands: Nursing program requires supplemental admission criteria. Contact campus for more information.

Chico: Impacted at the first-time freshman level and programs in Nursing and Option in Recording Arts (BA in Music Industry and Technology).

Dominguez Hills: Impacted programs in Cytotechnology Option (Clinical Science) and Prosthetics Option (Health Science).

Fresno: Impacted programs in Nursing and Athletic Training option (Kinesiology). Systemwide impaction including wait listing of non-local applicants for first-time freshmen applicants.

Fullerton: Impacted at the first-time freshman class level and upper division transfer level. Impacted programs in pre-nursing (first-time freshmen level) and upper division level programs (with supplementary admission criteria) in business (all majors), communications (all majors), kinesiology, nursing (BSN), health sciences, human services, child and adolescent development, psychology, sociology, and history.

Long Beach: Impacted at the first-time freshman class level and upper division transfer level. Impacted programs in Art (Option in Studio Art) and Bachelor of Fine Arts. Also impacted are programs in biology, business administration (all majors), communication studies, criminal justice, design, English, film and electronic arts, health science (option in radiation therapy technology), history, journalism, industrial design, interior design, kinesiology (options in athletic training, exercise science, and kinesiotherapy), liberal studies, nursing (basic), political science, psychology, social work, and sociology.

Northridge: The bachelor's degrees (Accountancy and Finance) as well as Option in Financial Services are impacted. Other programs in Business Administration are not impacted. Systemwide impaction including possible wait listing of non-local applicants has been implemented for first-time freshmen admission.

Pomona: Impacted at the first-time freshmen and upper-division transfer level. Impacted programs at the first-time freshmen and upper-division transfer level include: Animal Health Science, Animal Science, Architecture, Civil Engineering, and Mechanical Engineering.

San Diego: Impacted at the first-time freshmen class level and at the upper-division transfer level; impacted programs in most majors, concentrations, or emphases. *(Contact campus for more information.)*

San Jose: Impacted programs in business administration, communication studies, economics, journalism/mass communication, justice studies, kinesiology, liberal studies, nursing/pre-nursing, occupational studies, psychology, and social work as well as programs in engineering (aerospace, civil/environmental, computer, electrical, general, and mechanical).

San Luis Obispo: All majors are impacted. *(Please contact Cal Poly San Luis Obispo for details.)*

San Marcos: Impacted for business administration, communication, human development, kinesiology, mass media, and nursing programs. Systemwide impaction including possible wait listing of non-local applicants has been implemented for first-time freshmen admission.

Sonoma: Impacted for first-time freshmen and programs in communication studies, human development, liberal studies, nursing, and psychology.
