Please note that PFAs are not intended to be a means of providing working capital advances, nor overcoming cash flow problems. They are also not to be used to distort interest earnings or potential interest earnings between funds.

Subject: The California State University Systemwide Reimbursement
Plan of Financial Adjustment

Dear Mr. Westly,

In accordance with Sections 11251 and 16365 of the Government Code, we request that you approve this systemwide Reimbursement Plan of Financial Adjustment ("Plan") for The California State University (CSU). This Plan is intended to include all funds used by twenty-four entities of the CSU 6620 through 6850.

I request that this Plan begin July 1, 2004 and continue in effect thereafter from year to year, until amended or rescinded. Additionally, this plan when approved will supersede all previously approved plans for organization codes 6620 through 6850.

1. On the basis of the data set forth in the records maintained at the identified CSU entity, The California State University entity will identify amounts expended in one fund which are properly allocable to another fund or funds. On the basis of the data set forth in the records maintained at the Chancellor's Office (Organization Entities 6620), amounts of income and expense will be recharged to and from the other organizational entities within The California State University.
2. The funds on Attachment B are covered by this plan.
3. As required, the CSU entity will file a request with the State Controller to reimburse expenditures from the fund where the original expenditure was incurred to the fund(s) where the expenditure should be charged.
4. Requests for reimbursement under this plan will be accompanied by such supporting detail as the State Controller may require.
5. Amounts deposited in Fund 498 - Higher Education Fees & Income, CSU will be transferred to General Fund Support.

- 6. Requests for reimbursements under this plan will be:
 - a. Addressed to the State Controller, Division of Accounting, P.O. Box 942850, Sacramento, CA 94250.
 - b. Certified by an authorized officer of The California State University entity on the submission form.
 - c. Submitted on the CSU standard Reimbursement Plan of Financial Adjustment form which will contain the following language:

"I hereby certify under penalty of perjury that I am duly appointed, qualified and acting officer of the herein named State agency, department, board, commission, office or institution; that the within transfer is in all respects true, correct, and in accordance with all applicable provisions or restrictions in the Budget Act, Federal Regulations, or other statute pertaining to the particular appropriation."
