

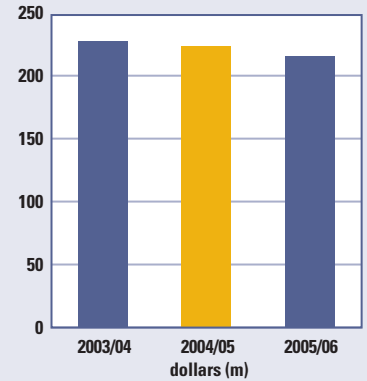
System Highlights

The CSU Board of Trustees recognized leadership gifts to the university by naming the following academic programs or facilities in 2005-2006:

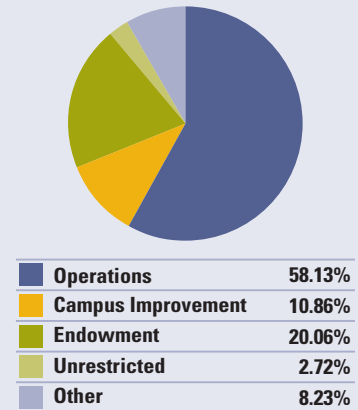
- The Martin V. Smith School of Business and Economics at CSU Channel Islands honors the memory of Mr. Smith, a leading real estate investor and developer in Ventura County, whose family generously committed \$8 million.
- The estate of alumna Mary Bayramian and her husband Jack bestowed \$7.3 million for a scholarship fund at CSU Northridge. The student services center was named the Mary and Jack Bayramian Hall in their memory.
- Uka Solanki, president and CEO of Big Saver Foods, and his wife, Nalini, contributed \$500,000 to endow the Yadunandan Center for India Studies at CSU Long Beach.
- The McMahan House at CSU San Marcos recognizes the \$2 million contribution by JoAn and Richard A. McMahan to construct and furnish the new event facility.
- The Broad Athletic Facility acknowledges a \$2 million contribution by the Eli and Edythe L. Broad Foundation to CSU Sacramento for a new athletic facility and field house.
- The La Kretz Wing at CSU Los Angeles recognizes contributions totaling \$2.5 million by the La Kretz Family Foundation for construction of the Integrated Sciences Complex and an endowed fund for the environmental sciences.

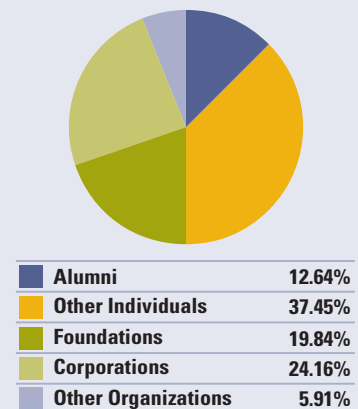
Charitable Gifts: A 3-Year History

System Highlights

- A \$4.5 million grant from the City of Palm Desert Redevelopment Agency resulted in the construction of the Palm Desert Health Sciences Building at the CSU San Bernardino, Palm Desert campus.
- The Lucas Graduate School of Business honors Donald and Sally Lucas for a \$10 million commitment to San José State University for initiatives to attract professors that are global business thought leaders and to recruit top-level graduate students.
- CSU Fullerton alumnus Dan Black contributed \$4.5 million to renovate laboratory space, purchase equipment and support scholarships in physics. In honor of his leadership, the facility was named Dan Black Hall.
- Namings at San Diego State include the J. R. Filanc Construction and Engineering Management Program, recognizing a \$3 million gift made by Jack R. and Jane E. Filanc; Manchester Hall, which honors Douglas F. and Elizabeth C. Manchester for a \$5 million gift for campus priorities, the golf program and faculty support; the Sycuan Band of the Kumeyaay Nation Institute on Tribal Gaming for a \$5 million gift for Hospitality and Tourism Management; and the QUALCOMM Institute for Innovation and Educational Success, acknowledging a \$14.5 million gift.
