

System Highlights

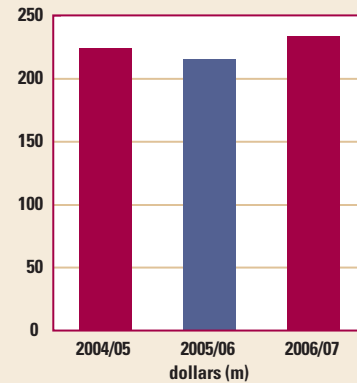
- The Alfred P. Sloan Foundation awarded \$891,000 to develop Professional Science Master's Programs at 12 campuses to meet critical workforce needs in science and technology.
- Trustee Emeritus Murray L. Galinson created a scholarship endowment to recognize the William Randolph Hearst/CSU Trustees' Award for Outstanding Achievement recipient who performed the most community service.
- The estate of Agnes K. Marks distributed over \$1 million, which will be used to support capital projects at multiple campuses.

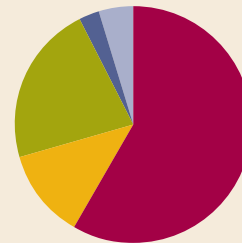

Charitable Gifts: A 3-Year History

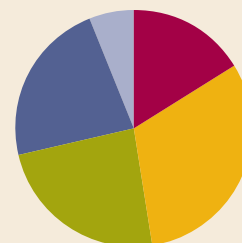


Charitable Gifts by Gift Disbursement
