Contribution Highlights:

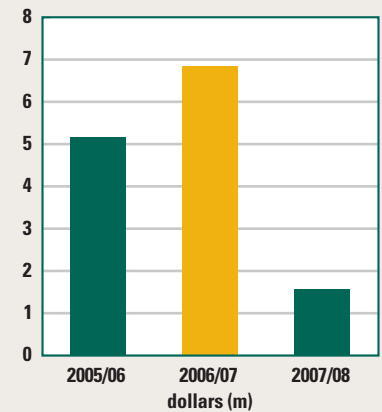

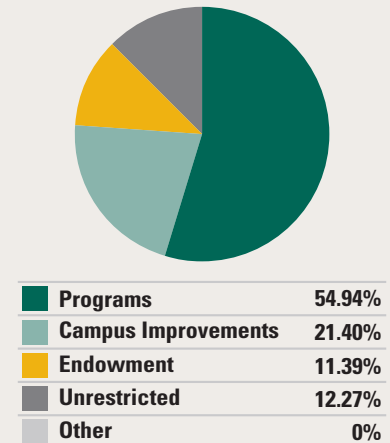
