Contribution Highlights:

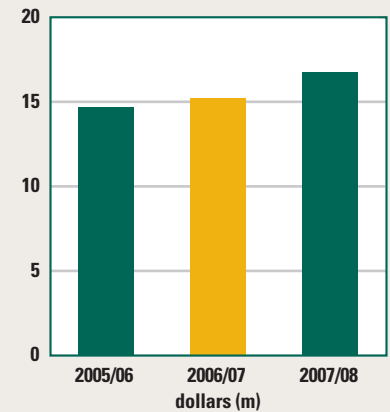
- Community Engagement garnered a \$3.5 million commitment reflecting the donors' deep-seated community service values. The program facilitated over 600,000 hours of student volunteer service during the year.
- A local university friend bequeathed \$2 million to refurbish the Farm Market and endow a fund for equine studies.
- The Fresno State Comprehensive Campaign reached \$80.8 million during its quiet phase toward the nucleus fund goal of \$100 million by December 2008.
- An alumnus from the 1950s bequeathed assets totaling over \$5 million, endowing scholarships for international and other students, in honor of his parents.

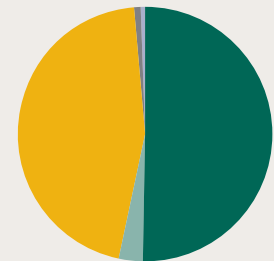

Charitable Gifts: A 3-Year History

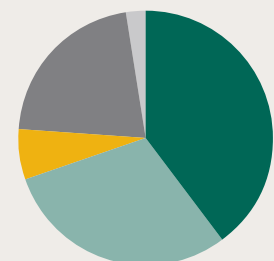


Charitable Gifts by Gift Disbursement
