## Contribution Highlights:

- Ensuring her husband's legacy of high academic and business standards, Gertrude Lamden and family made a \$10 million gift to name the nationally recognized School of Accountancy after her late husband, Charles W. Lamden, the first dean of the College of Business Administration.
- A \$1.25 million gift from Darlene Shiley established the Donald P. Shiley Center for Cardiovascular Research in the SDSU Bioscience Center to honor her husband's contributions to the cardiovascular field.
- Susie and Dean Spanos, owners of the San Diego Chargers football team, contributed \$25,000 aimed at supporting the campus police's proactive efforts to reduce illegal drug sales on campus.
- The late Phillips L. Claud, Jr. left his estate to his alma mater, which will use the \$1.2 million bequest to support excellent research and instructional facilities at the Mount Laguna Observatory.
- Former SDSU employee Larry Willens made a gift of \$900,000 to support the women's tennis program.

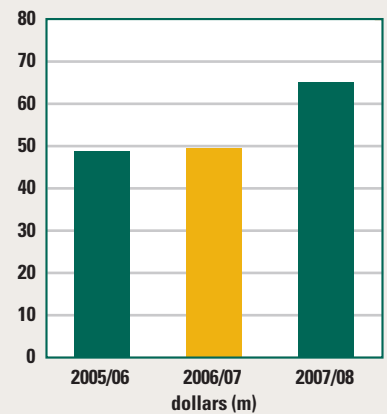

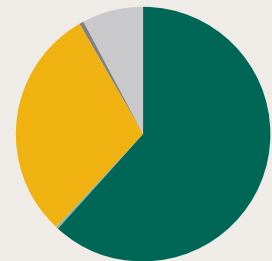

### Charitable Gifts: A 3-Year History

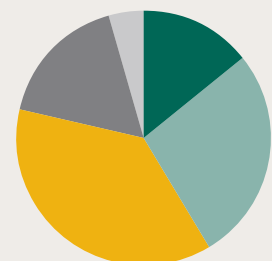


### Charitable Gifts by Gift Disbursement
