Contribution Highlights:

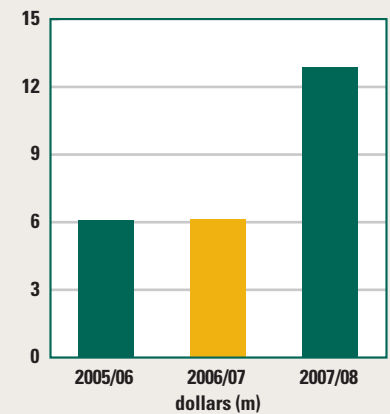
- Schroeder's Recital Hall, at the Donald and Maureen Green Music Center, was named in recognition of a \$4 million gift from Jean Schulz, alumna of Sonoma State University and wife of the late cartoonist Charles Schulz.
- An anonymous donor committed a \$2.5 million challenge gift, fully matched dollar-to-dollar, resulting in a total of \$5 million in new gifts to support the construction of the Green Music Center, which is destined to become one of the most sought-after music and arts venues in the world, featuring an acoustically superb concert hall that will draw both master and student musicians.
- Private donations supported the public lecture series "What Physicists Do" and public viewing nights at the observatory.

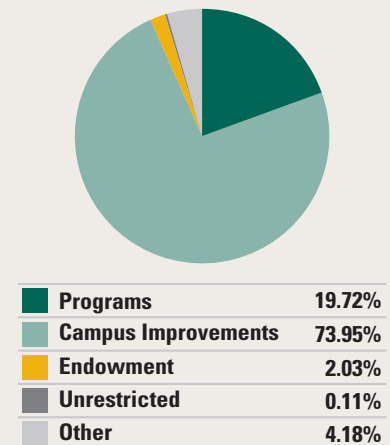
