Contribution Highlights:

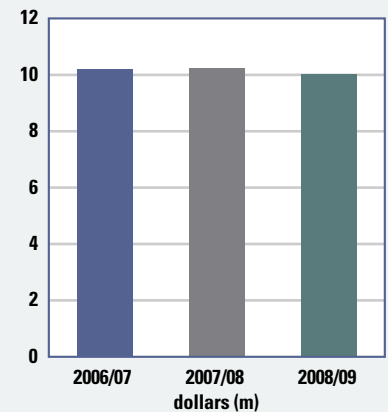
- A \$5 million testamentary commitment was received from alumnus Les Harper and his wife, Anita, for undergraduate scholarships.
- The campus received from anonymous donors a collection, valued at more than \$1.38 million, of works by renowned artist and CSU Sacramento alumnus Wayne Thiebaud. The works will be shown in spring 2010 at the university's gallery.
- The William and Flora Hewlett Foundation provided \$591,490 toward multiyear pledges to support the Institute for Higher Education Leadership and Policy Studies and the Brokers of Expertise project.
- Former faculty member and administrator Earline L. Ames left the university a \$315,000 estate gift to benefit students studying to become teachers. Dr. Ames made the unusual distinction that all the funds must be spent within a 10-year period.
- The Stuart Foundation made a \$175,000 contribution that will benefit the Sacramento Region Guardian Scholars Consortium, which provides mentoring and other support for former foster children.

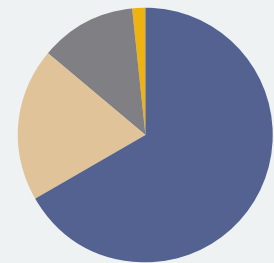

Charitable Gifts: A 3-Year History

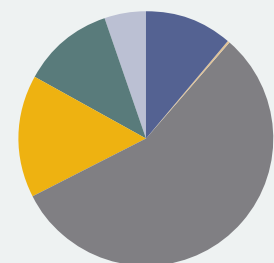


Charitable Gifts by Gift Disbursement
