Some students will be required to take supported courses in some cases, if their placement information leads us to that determination

Academic Preparation	Since you are not requiring SAT/ ACT scores, what will you use for class placement?	We consider the senior year math and English courses, GPA in math classes, SBAC/EAP scores, and test scores if available. We also use directed self-placement.

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Academic Preparation	If we don't have MRWC, what other classes would count for Math Quantitative course?	Yes, Area C courses count.
Academic Preparation	What is the best MRWC class a senior can take?	It is dependent on if the student is interested in a STEM or non-STEM major. Detailed placement information can be found on the CSU Student Success site: http://csustudentsuccess.org/home
Academic Preparation	what are examples of Mathematics/quantitative reasoning courses?	Algebra, geometry, any course with Algebra 2 as a pre-requisite are all qualifying math courses for a through g
Academic Preparation	If English and Math uses test scores and grades for placement, how will you handle this without test scores?	There are several factors that are used to place students in English and math. Grades in particular courses, senior year math and English courses, SBAC scores and directed self placement will be used.
Academic Preparation	how will you place students if they do not have SAT scores	The placement into math and English is determined on senior year math and English courses, grades in math courses, SBAC/EAP, standardized test scores, and directed self-placement.
Admission	Will the CSU's want students to take the AP tests for admission evaluation process?	If you have official AP exam test scores you can still send those in to your CSU campus to have those evaluated for college credit. Contact your campus directly for more details on their process.
Admission	Will online lab courses (Biology, Chemistry) be accepted by CSU as A-G compliant?	As long as the course is "a-g" approved in the UC Course Management Portal the CSU will accept the course regardless of the mode of instruction.
Admission	how will you calculate GPAs if a school is giving letter grades for spring 2020 but the high school is not using this semester in their own calculation of the GPA?	Freshmen evaluators will use a combination of grades from semesters prior to Spring 2020 and Pass/Credit grades to determine GPA and whether or not the student meets a through g requirements. If a student was repeating classes Spring 2020 to improve their GPA, we will assume they have passed the class and not count the D or F from a previous term.
Admission	"validate subject deficiencies"? Can you explain more about this? Give an example please.	Students will be able to validate courses with grades of CR/Pass. For example, if a student was taking Chemistry this year (19/20) and received a D first semester and a grade of CR 2nd semester (Spring 2020), the CR will validate the 1st semester.
Admission	How will students who receive grades be compared to those students who receive CR, since CSU uses GPA to determine eligibility.	Students who choose to use grades will have the GPA impacted by those grades but it doesn't make any one student more or less competitive unless overall GPA goes up or down etc. Contact each campus to review all admission criteria. Admission	What if a school is giving a pass for a D? How would you know if it was a D?	The evaluator at the CSU will consider all passing grades as meeting the a through g requirement and it will not affect the GPA in any way
Admission	If a student takes a summer school class to clear a grade from a year or two before and summer school is only pass/no pass would a pass clear that earlier deficiency?	Grades of CR/PASS will only be considered for courses in winter, spring, summer 2020. Any other terms will not be considered.
Admission	I know typically UCs and CSUs DO NOT accept ONLINE lab science. Is this still the case for student making up failed classes that are taking them over online platforms due to COVID?	We accept all courses that are on the a-g UC CMP regardless of mode of instruction
Admission	If a high school student takes one quarter of VPA course at a community college, does it fulfill the yearlong VPA requirement?	Yes, one term at the community college is the same as 1 year at the high school
Admission	What is "the bump" ..1 point? 2 points? .5?	A weighted grade is generally a 1 point boost (B=A etc. for an AP/honors/IB/college level course)
Admission	Will uncapped GPA be considered or still limit to 8 semester honors credit?	This has not changed. It is still limited.
Admission	If you remediate a course and replace the D or F with a better grade, will the poor grade be averaged with the good grade, or will the higher grade be the only grade calculated into the GPA?	A repeated grade is removed and the new grade is used as long as the course is the same.
Admission	Will credit recovery (HS) ONLINE lab courses (Biology, Chemistry) be accepted by CSU as A-G compliant?	The CSU will accept courses that are approved by the UC as "a-g". Keep in mind repeated courses are the exact same course, within the same high schools district and the same level of course.
Admission	My school offers Journalism which is an area G-approved course in the English discipline, I assume that would count as a 5th year of English for Cal Poly SLO or would a 5th year have to be an additional year of core English (e.g. senior English). CSU campuses primarily use self-reported information from Cal State Apply to determine admission decisions. If a campus will need 7th semester transcripts for review, they will contact the student specifically.
Admission	What if high schools don't offer a 5th year of English or don't allow students to take 2 math or English courses per year? Is there a way for students to explain this?	College coursework, 2 semesters of High School consideration for each college term completed (1 term of English Comp at a community college would give an applicant 2 semesters of HS consideration).
Admission	If a student was retaking a course that they received a D or F in and received a Pass the second time, will the D/F be dropped from their GPA calculation?	Yes, the D/F grade will be dropped from the GPA for a repeated course. But the course must be the exact same course.
Admission	Will you be test blind beyond the class of 2021? What will be your policy in the future and if no decision was made when will you decide?	No decision has been made.
Admission	Will admission reps be still be available via Zoom to promote their CSU campuses, and speak to high school students?	Generally speaking, yes. Please check with individual campuses on their zoom/webinar offerings.

Admission	Will passing grades in Algebra II validate a D second semester of geometry	Algebra 2 does not validate Geometry
Admission	Does the new Testing policy apply to GRE for grad applicants?	You should contact your specific CSU graduate programs you're applying to for updates on GRE or testing requirements
Admission	Also, will student have the option to defer for Fall?	Each campus has developed their own policies regarding admission deferrals; please contact your specific institution.
Admission	If a student get a D in Calculus first semester, and gets a C in the second semester, will the C in the second semester validate the D in first semester?	Yes. The student will receive the year long subject credit, but pending if the student took the course in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade, then the grades will be factored into the GPA.

Admission - 2021-22	What is our high school doesn't offer AVID? CSU does not look at school profiles so would a student indicate no AVID available on their applications?	Students will be asked not only about AVID , but other programs as well and there is an other sections. These questions are currently asked in the EOP section of the application.

Students with a GPA between 2.00 and 2.49 MAY be evaluated for admission based on supplemental factors. So not all campuses will review this population for admission. Which campuses will evaluate these students will be provided later this summer.

All campuses are working on their multiple factor admissions that will address those students are in the range of 2.49 or lower. It is still recommended that a student take math their senior year if they are applying to a STEM major. But it is not required if they have satisfied Algebra 2 and a year of geometry

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Admission - 2021-22	How will min. 2.5 GPA be calculated if P/NP courses are included?	Pass and Credit grades will not be included in the GPA calculation.
Cal State Apply	I have several students who took their foreign language online with LanguageBird when it was fully UC/CSU a-g approved. It has since been changed to only count if the student's home high school agrees to put it on their transcript. The UC system has a list of students who fall into this category and have agreed to accept these classes. How can/should a student report these classes on the CSU app?	As long as the course was approved, on the "a-g list, for the academic year the student took the course it will be accepted. The student would enter the course just as any other course.
Cal State Apply	Will you continue to use Californiacolleges website to link with the Cal state apply app and are there changes to Cal Apply? Will it still just open Oct 1st?	Yes, the CSU will continue to partner with Cal Colleges and the application will open October 1, 2020.
Cal State Apply	Will you continue to use the high school planner on Californiacolleges website	Yes, the CSU will continue to partner with Cal Colleges and the application will open October 1, 2020.
Cal State Apply	I'm sorry, I missed the tool for students to use to import grades without manually entering, what is that?	The CSU partners with Californiacolleges.edu for a high school planner and allows students to import their high school coursework. This save students time while completing the admission application.
Cal State Apply	how does the import process work?	School districts that are contracted with Cal Colleges load their grades in to the HS planner. Open Access districts can also have their students use the planner and manually enter their grades. At the time of application the student links their Cal Colleges account to their Cal State Apply account and then import their high school coursework data.
Cal State Apply	How do you want student to report dual enrollment if one is listed as an English course and another as an Ethnic Studies course differently from each campus?	All college should be reported under the college they attended and then matched on the A-G Matching screen. The courses should be matched to the appropriate category.

School districts that are contracted with Cal Colleges load their grades in to the HS planner. Open Access districts can also have their students use the planner and manually enter their grades. At the time of application the student links their Cal Colleges account to their Cal State Apply account and then import their high school coursework data.
Cal State Apply	For supplemental criteria will you ask students to actually list their work experience and activities or will you just ask the total hours in the last year like Cal Poly does now?	Yes, the questions will be similar to those currently asked by Cal Poly but will be asked of all first-time freshman applying to the CSU.
