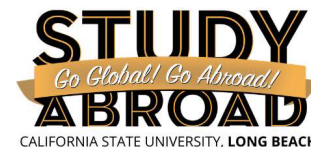

# BEACH PLEDGE PROGRAM

The California Promise Program enables a specific number of campuses of the California State University (CSU) to establish pledge programs for entering first time students who are both interested and able to complete baccalaureate degrees in 4 years for first time first years and 2 years for eligible ADT transfers. The California Promise program (SB412) enables CSULB to establish the Beach Pledge Program.

# FIRST TIME FIRST YEAR ADMISSION

## CSU ELIGIBILITY

Complete all A-G coursework with a C or better

Maintain an average CSU GPA of 2.5 or higher (weighted)

CSU GPA includes all A-G coursework in 10<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> grade

## CSULB INDEX

(200 x CSU GPA) + (500 x Math GPA) + (500 x English GPA)

3200 minimum (CA residents)

Math GPA includes all Category C courses in 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade

English GPA includes all Category B courses in 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade

Each GPA calculation is weighted and permits up to 8 honor points

## CSULB STEM INDEX

(600 x Math GPA) + (600 x Science GPA)

Additional index used for STEM & Nursing applicants

3600 minimum (CA residents)

## SUPPLEMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

All majors are impacted

Some majors may request additional application materials

Music and Dance require a live audition

Visit your department's website for information on supplemental application requirements

# LOCAL PREFERENCE



CSULB local preference is based on high school of graduation or military service

## FIRST TIME FIRST YEAR APPLICANTS

Must be CSU eligible and meet CSULB minimum requirements

Admitted as undeclared if not admitted to major of choice

## TRANSFER APPLICANTS

Must be CSU eligible and meet all major specific requirements

Admitted to major of choice

Does not apply to Dance, Music, Nursing, or Social Work
