








California Colleges Integration




Course Entry








Dual Enrollment/College Coursework

- The application will automatically grant a full year of high school credit for each college course inputted





Dual Enrollment Courses

PALOMAR COLLEGE Transcript

Spring May 2023 - Fall August 2023

- · Enter Pass grades as "P" and Credit grades as "CR."
- Repeats: If your transcript identifies the course as repeated and excludes the course from the college/institution GPA, enter a grade of "RP," unless the repeat is in progress. If a repeat is in progress, the original grade is reported.
- Academic Renewal: If your college offers academic renewal, use a grade of AR for courses noted as such on the transcript.



- LOTE C or better in a semester of a higher-level course validates a lower-level course
