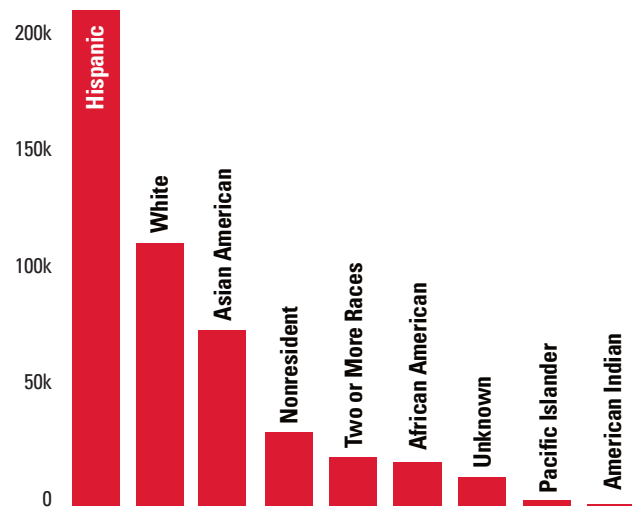

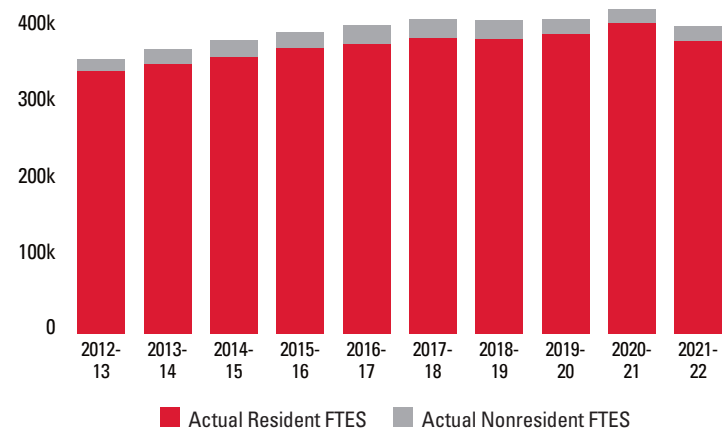

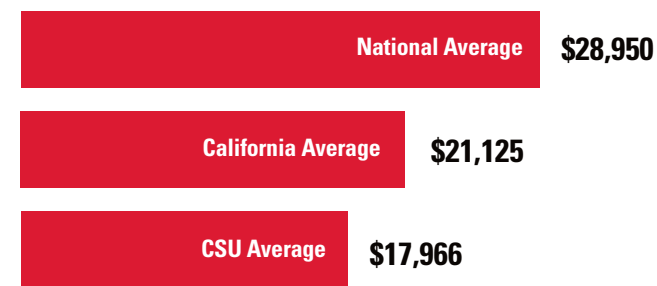
**CSU SERVES A DIVERSE STUDENT POPULATION**



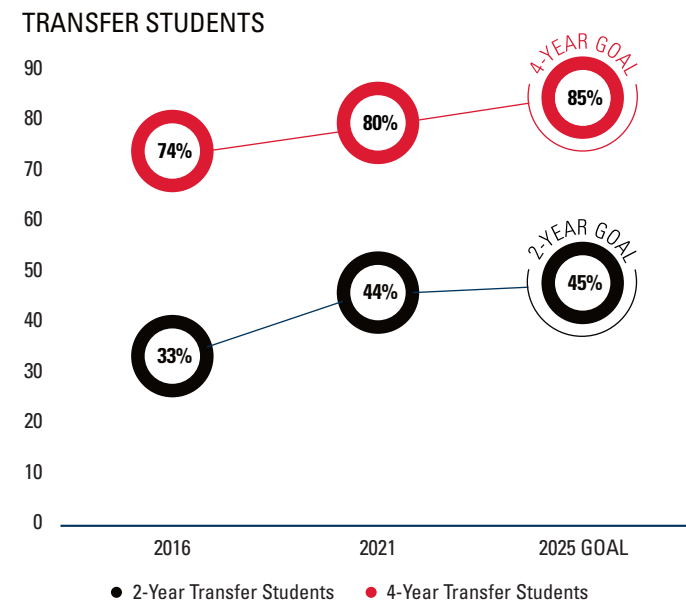
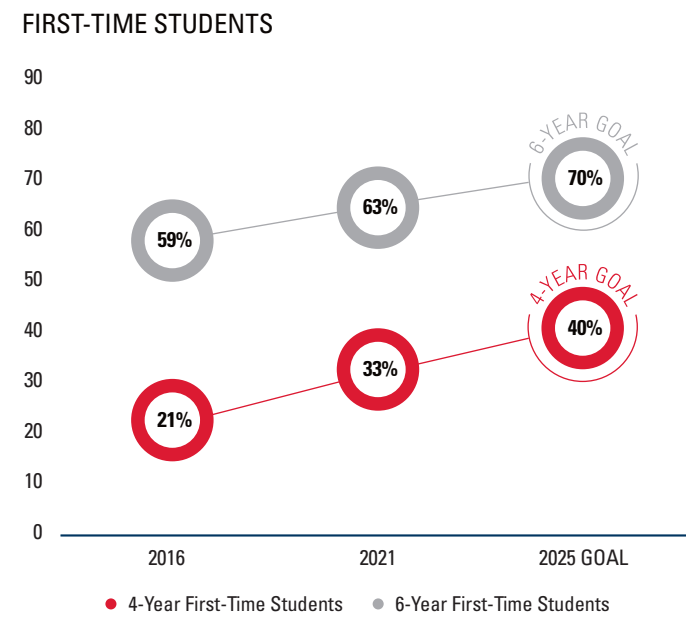

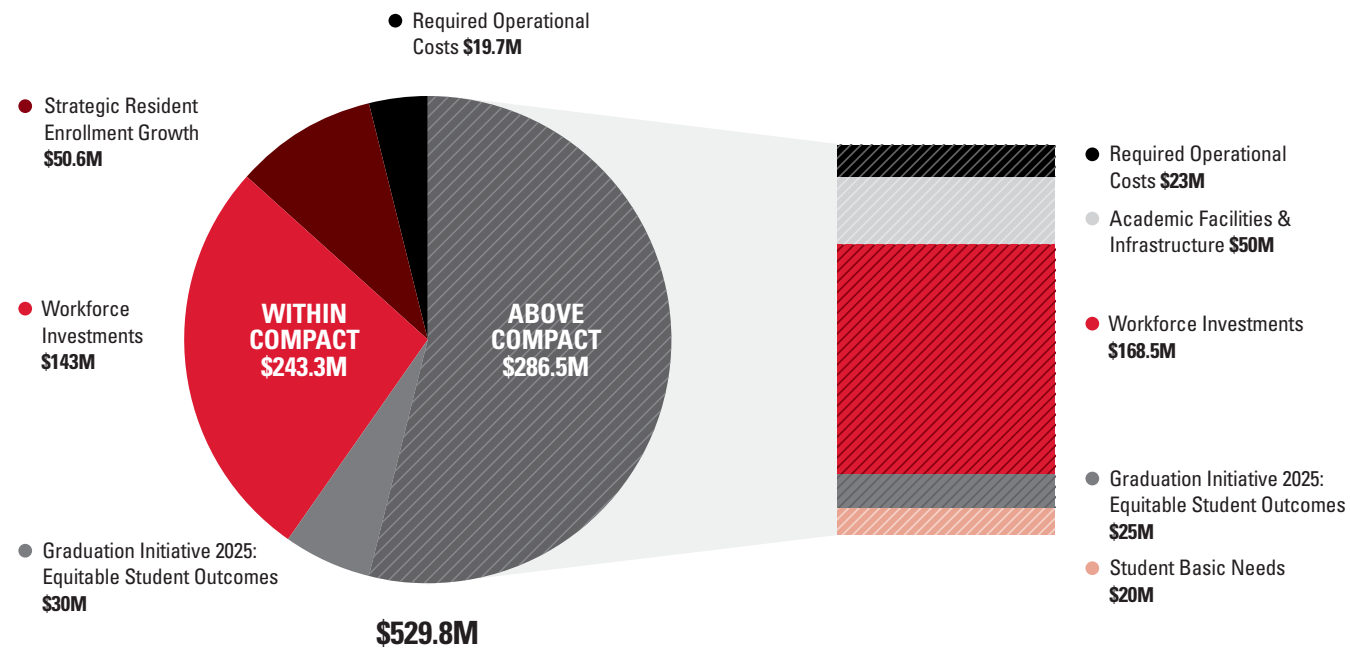
