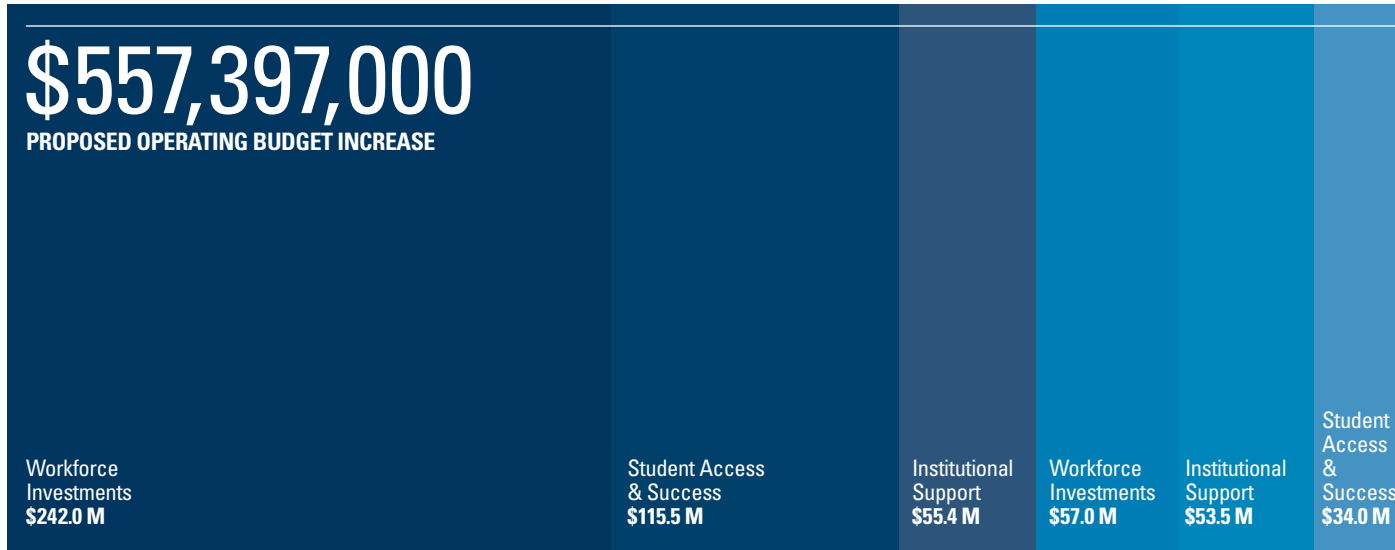


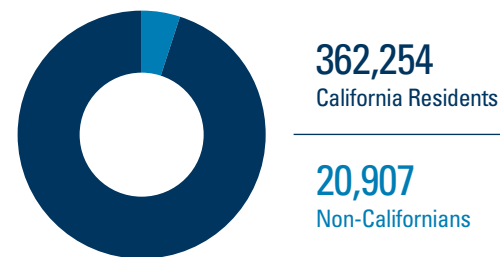

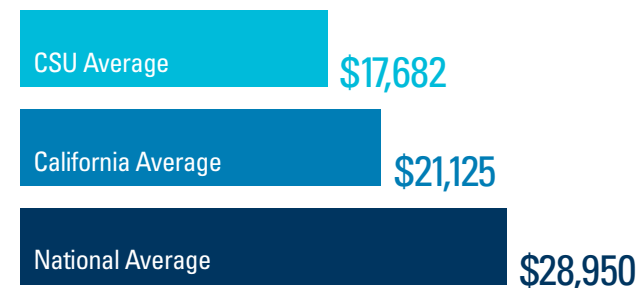

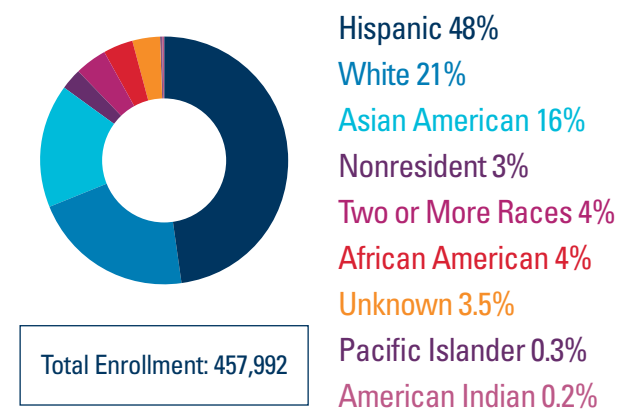
CSU STUDENTS HAVE LOWER AVERAGE DEBT

(Based on average resident undergrad with recommended rate increase for 2024-25)

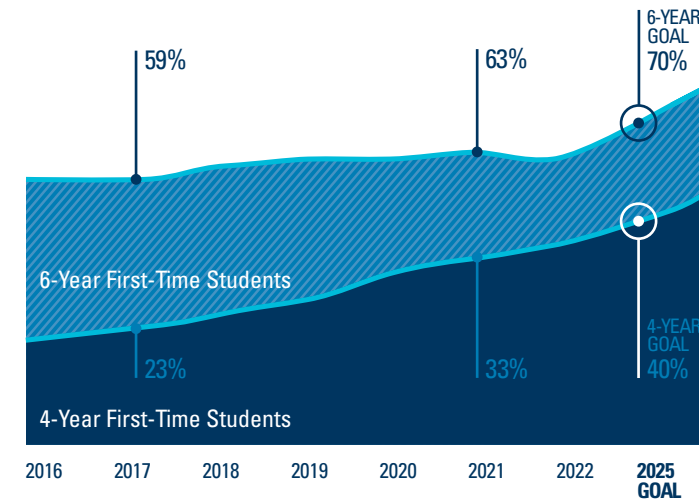


CSU SERVES A DIVERSE STUDENT POPULATION

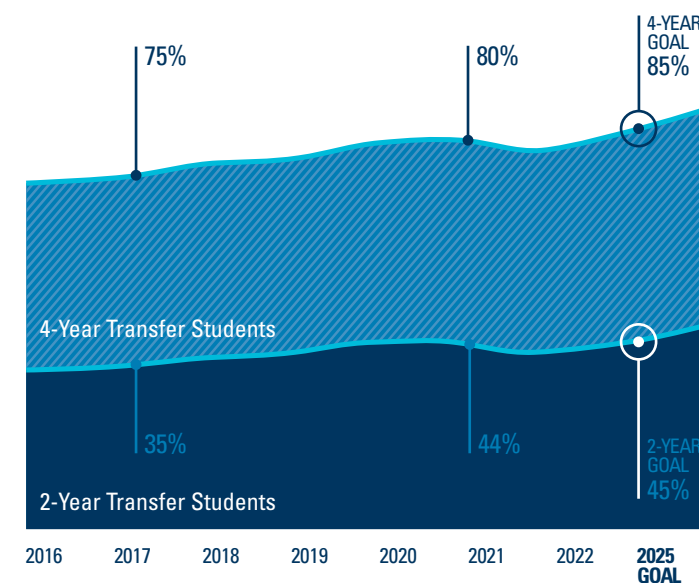


CSU IS MAKING PROGRESS ON GRADUATION RATE GOALS BY 2025
