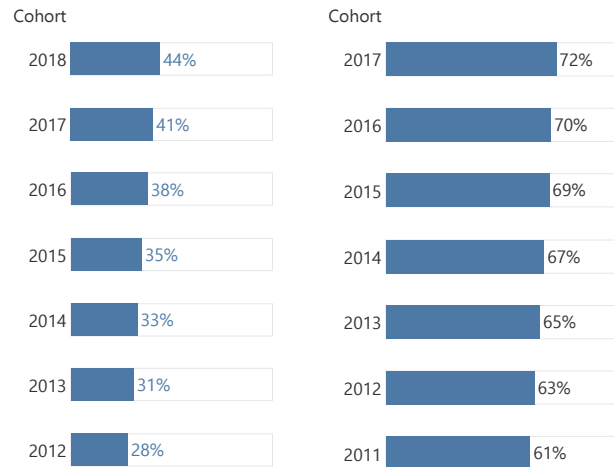
#### FALL FIRST-TIME FRESHMEN COHORT

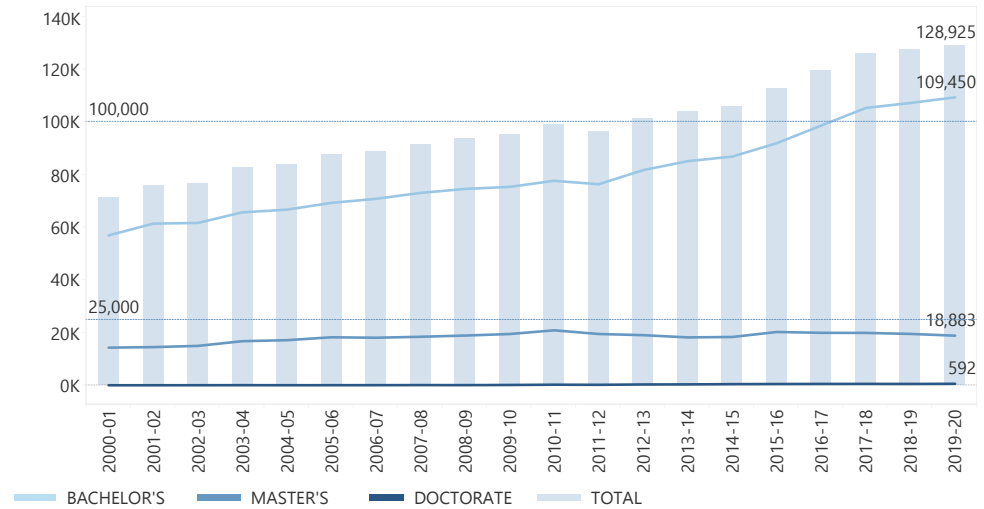
