RE: California State University Report: Assembly Bill 386/1062, Cross-Enrollment: Online Education

This report provides data on online education for the California State University's academic year of 2019-2020, including information on course enrollment, completion rates, grade point average, and completion rates for degree programs that include online courses and no online courses. The report also provides information regarding enrollment and course completion rates of students cross-enrolled in online courses by campus, student level, and student demographic subgroup. Data shows that cross-enrollment in online courses has increased by more than 48% from fall 2019 to spring 2020, independent of the CSU's transition to virtual instruction in spring 2020 necessitated by the COVID-19 pandemic.

The California State University launched the CSU Fully Online course catalog to help students obtain the courses they need, maximize access and reduce bottleneck courses, thereby improving student success and timely graduation for students through the use of

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innovative online technologies. Through CSU Fully Online, CSU undergraduate students have the opportunity to take one free fully online course per semester/quarter offered at another CSU campus every term.

The CSU Fully Online course catalog is the central location for CSU students to find and enroll in online courses available at other CSU campuses. The information can be found at: <http://www.csufullyonline.com>.

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Report Summary

Assembly Bill No. 386/1062

Cross-enrollment: Online Education

January 2021

Section 89226 of the Education Code reads as follows: (a) On or before January 15, 2019 (as updated by Assembly Bill 1062), and on or before January 15 every two years thereafter, the trustees shall report to the Legislature key performance data on online courses as defined in Section 89225, including, but not necessarily limited to, all of the following:

(1) The number of students enrolled at each campus.

Please refer to Summary Table for Item 1 State-supported and Summary Table for Item 1 Self-supported.

During the academic year of 2019-2020:

Total number of students enrolled in state-supported program in fall 2019 is 481,929, winter 2020 is 39,658, and spring 2020 is 446,973.

Total number of students enrolled in self-supported program in fall 2019 is 15,350, winter 2020 is 526, and spring 2020 is 19,400.

(2) Course completion rates for courses other than online course.

Please refer to Summary Table for Item 2.

During the academic year of 2019-2020, course completion rates for courses other than online courses are 93% for fall 2019, 95.3% for winter 2020, and 92.3% for spring 2020. Completion rates vary by campus, student level, and student demographics.

(3) Completion rates for degree programs that include no online courses.

Please refer to Summary Table for Items 3 and 7.

During the academic year 2019-2020, 94.4% of the degrees earned included no online courses and 5.6% of the degrees earned included online or hybrid courses.

(4) Grade point average for students enrolled in online courses.

Please refer to Summary Table for Item 4.

During the 2019-2020 academic year, the grade point average for students enrolled in online courses is 3.13 for fall 2019, 3.46 for winter 2020, and 3.49 for spring 2020.

(5) The number of students (full-time equivalent and headcount) cross-enrolled in online courses at a California State University campus other than the campus at which they are matriculated.

Please refer to Summary Table for Item 5.

In fall 2019, 639 students were cross-enrolled in online courses at a California State University campus other than the campus at which they are matriculated. The headcount is 16 for winter 2020, and 950 for spring 2020.

(6) Course completion rates for students enrolled in online courses.

Please refer to Summary Table for Item 6.

During the academic year of 2019-2020, completion rates for online courses are 91.2% for fall 2019, 94.7% for winter 2020, and 92.7% for spring 2020. Completion rates vary by campus, student level, and student demographics. Completion rates should be interpreted with caution, as some of the subgroups are fairly small.

(7) Completion rates for degree programs that include online courses.

(8) Student enrollment (full-time equivalent and headcount) in all state-supported online courses, disaggregated by undergraduate and graduate students, as well as by campus.

In fall 2019, 181,380 students were enrolled in state-supported online courses, 2,140 in winter 2020, and 267,833 in spring 2020.

(9) Cross-campus online enrollment (full-time equivalent and headcount) by host campus.

(10) Successful course completion rates in cross-campus online courses.

Please refer to Summary Table for Item 10.

During the academic year of 2019-2020, successful course completion rates for cross-campus online courses are 82.2% for fall 2019, 100% for winter 2020, and 81.9% for spring 2020.

Successful completion rates should be interpreted with caution as many of the subgroups are fairly small.

(11) Courses completed by cross-enrolled online students, specifying the type of academic credit they received, including lower division, upper division, or graduate level.

Please refer to Summary Table for Item 11.

During the academic year of 2019-2020, 85% of lower division cross-enrolled online students completed their courses, 81.7% in upper division, and 87.5% in graduate level. 56% of the courses completed by cross-enrolled online students are upper division level courses.

Notes:

- The original course mode assigned to courses was used for spring 2020 in this report, even though the course modality for a majority of spring 2020 courses changed to virtual/on-line in response to COVID-19.
- California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo submitted all of their spring 2020 courses as online mode because their 2020 spring term started *after* the COVID-19 course modality modification was implemented.
- Grades A+ through D- and Credit are considered as course completion.
- Grades A+ through C- and Credit are considered as *successful* course completion.
- Grade point averages were calculated using enrolled online course grades.
- Student level indicates the current academic level of the student.
