RE: Disaster Relief Emergency Student Financial Aid

Article 22.5 of Senate Bill 116 states that the California State University (CSU) Office of the Chancellor shall report to the Department of Finance and the Joint Legislative Budget Committee on the distribution of \$3 million in Disaster Relief Emergency Student Aid allocated to the CSU in 2020. The attached chart provides details on the number of students served, the total amount of student financial aid provided, and the average award amount provided to qualifying students.

Awarded during a time of great social and financial upheaval, this funding was of tremendous benefit to more than 9,000 undocumented CSU students, allowing them to persist in their studies. These students remain ineligible for financial aid and other federal assistance. As the CSU works to close equity gaps and increase graduation rates, we strongly encourage the legislature to identify additional state grant dollars to assist these deserving scholars in the future.
