Antifreeze/Lubricating Oil: CSU plans to reach out to the DOT for best practices. CSU has created a committee to implement a system wide contract to improve these areas. Glass: CSU will work with Capital Construction to develop a plan to implement recycled glass in construction products. And will reach out to the Dept of Education for best practices. Paint: CSU will reach to CHCF and the Dept of Public Health to collaborate on best practices. Paper Products: Due to COVID, paper product use was greatly reduced. The CSU will work to improve this area. Plastic Prod: Due in reduction of printing, the use of recycled plastic toner cartridge consumption was greatly reduced. Tires: CSU will reach out to Cal Buy Recycle. The majority of tires purchased by the CSU are under 15" in diameter. Recycled tires are not manufactured below 15".
