What is CaliforniaColleges.edu?

A one-stop, data-informed platform, providing tools and curricula that:

- Helps students create plans and launch CA public college and financial aid applications.
- Informs parents about the topics that matter most.
- Enables educators to track student progress.



What is CCGI?

The California College Guidance Initiative (CCGI) manages CaliforniaColleges.edu. Our objectives are:

- 1. All high school seniors graduate with clear postsecondary goals and a plan for how to achieve them.
- Students' academic transcript data follows them as they advance across educational systems to inform key decisions about admissions, placement, guidance, and financial aid.


Career Assessments

career goals.




Career Search Tool

Students can use the Career Search Tool to explore careers that match their preferences.




Major Search Tool

Students can use the Major Search Tool to explore majors related to their interests, and then they can see which colleges offer those majors.




College Search Tool

Students can use the College Search Tool to research and compare colleges to find the best fit.




My Plan

Students' college and career planning activity is saved in a personalized digital portfolio called My Plan.




Academic Planner

Students can use the Academic Planner to intentionally plan their high school coursework.




Academic Planner on CaliforniaColleges.edu

- The Academic Planner allows students to plan high school coursework.
- There are three simple steps to adding a course:
 - Select a subject area and grade level.
 - 2. Select a course from the dropdown menu that is populated by courses for that subject area and grade level as indicated in UCOP's Course Management Portal (CMP) or manually enter a course. Indicate term type, term, and status. See right.
 - Students click Submit, and the course is added to the planner.



Educator Dashboard

From the Educator Dashboard, educators can track local benchmarks, manage users, and run reports.



One-Stop-Shop: Students & Educators


- Students: A streamlined, reliable place to launch their public higher education college applications and financial aid within the state of CA.
- Educators: A centralized portal to track verified college and financial aid application status to provide targeted student support.

CCC Apply: Launching from CaliforniaColleges.edu




College Application: From the California Community Colleges
Application within the 'College' section in the hover menu.

A pop-up will appear. Students will **Type or Select CCC College** then click **Launch**. Once on the CCCApply page, students will begin the application process.



Financial aid: Launching from CaliforniaColleges.edu

Financial Aid Applications: From FAFSA or CA Dream Act link within the 'Financial Aid' section in the hover menu.





Once on the financial aid page, students will need to be signed in and click on the **Launch** button. Note: Button will be made available from Oct.1st through June 30th.


· Federal financial aid, like grants, work-study, or loans.


. Some school-based financial aid, like scholarships or grants given out by colleges.

. State financial aid, like the Cal Grant.

College Application: Students click
California State University
Application within the 'College'
section in the hover menu. A pop-up
will appear and students will click
Confirm to link the accounts.





Once on the Cal State Apply application, students will import their coursework. In the Academic History quadrant (within the High Schools Attended section), students click Show Me How.

Linking Accounts

Students can link their CaliforniaColleges.edu and Cal State Apply Accounts. This can be done in two ways:

- 1. Initiate Cal State Apply from CaliforniaColleges.edu.
- Initiate Cal State Apply from CalState.edu/Apply.


When students link their accounts, courses in their Academic Planner will move to Cal State Apply, and educators will have submission reports.


Steps for Requesting an Educator Account


Go to CaliforniaColleges.edu and follow these steps to request

your account:

 Click Sign In in the upper righthand corner of the homepage.

- 2. Click the **Register** link located below Sign In.
- If you have a signed AB 1584 on file, we connect you to the Site Admin.
- 4. If you do not have a signed AB 1584 on file, we will walk you through the steps to ensure that it is on file before we verify employment and distribute accounts.





Student Accounts on CaliforniaColleges.edu


There are benefits to creating accounts for your students.

- Eliminates time. Instead of guiding students to create their accounts, you can ensure all students who should have accounts, have them.
- If a district becomes a CCGI Partner, it makes linking old and new accounts easier.


