INFORMATIVE DIGEST

The California State University Catastrophic Leave Donation Program (Article 4.2 of Subchapter 7, Chapter 1, Division 5 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations) which addresses the catastrophic leave donation program is being updated to reflect changes to Section 42930 to include language which allows employees who accrue vacation or sick leave credits to voluntarily donate either of those credits to another employee within the California State University (CSU) system to be used for catastrophic leave in the event of a national disaster/state of emergency.

COST TO STATE AND LOCAL AGENCIES AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS

The adoption of the proposed amendment will not impose a cost or savings on any state agency; will not impose a cost or savings on any local agency or school district that is required to be reimbursed under Section 17561 of the Government Code; will not result in any nondiscretionary cost or savings to local agencies; will not result in any cost or savings in federal funding to the state; and will not impose a mandate on local agencies or school districts.
