

**Statement of Reasons for Repeal of
Title 5, California Code of Regulations, Sections 40530, 40531 and 40532**

Adopted by board action in 2004 (REP 07-04-04), Title 5 sections 40530, 40531 and 40532 provided a policy framework for establishing lower-division transfer patterns (LDTP), which were to be efficient transfer pathways from California Community College campuses to the completion of CSU degree programs. These three LDTP Title 5 sections are proposed for repeal because LDTP pathways were rendered obsolete when SB 1440 (Padilla) *The Student Transfer Achievement Reform Act* (or STAR Act) was signed into law in 2010, creating Associate Degrees for Transfer.
